COMPLAINT

NOW COMES, Plaintiffs, Scott Krise and Natalie Krise, husband and wife, by and through their attorneys, The Hopkins Law Firm, and avers as follows:

1. Plaintiffs are husband and wife who reside together at 998 Treasure Lake, DuBois, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, 15801.

2. The property to be quieted is described as follows:

All those certain parcels of land situate in Sandy Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania described as follows:

Parcel #1: Treasure Lake Lot 103, Section 15, identified as Clearfield County Assessment Map #128-D3-15-103-21;

Parcel #2: Treasure Lake Lot 104, Section #15, identified as Clearfield County Assessment Map #128-C02-15-104-21.

3. The Defendants are Richard Herr, Jean M. Herr, Carl F. Heitmeyer and Wanda K. Heitmeyer.

4. The whereabouts of the Defendants who are set forth above are unknown.

5. By deed dated November 12, 1970 and recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Clearfield County in Deed Book 590, at page 281. Treasure Lake, Inc., a Pennsylvania corporation, conveyed Lot 104, Section 15, in the Treasure Lake Subdivision to Carl F. Heitmeyer and Wanda K. Heitmeyer, husband and wife..

6. By deed dated May 15, 1978 and recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Clearfield County in Deed Book 764 at page 182, Treasure Lake of Pennsylvania, Inc., a Pennsylvania corporation, conveyed Lot 103, Section 15, in the Treasure Lake Subdivision unto Jean M. Herr, widow.

7. The said Lot 104, Section 15, of the Treasure Lake Subdivision owned by Carl F. Heitmeyer and Wanda K. Heitmeyer was subject to a tax sale by the Tax Claim Bureau of Clearfield County, Pennsylvania on September 18, 1987 for unpaid taxes.

8. By deed dated November 13, 1987 and recorded in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of Clearfield County in Deed Book 1194, page 219, the Tax Claim Bureau of Clearfield County, Pennsylvania conveyed Lot 104, Section 15, to Harry L. Mowrey and Florence A. Mowrey, husband and wife, and Patrick H. Mowrey and Kim Mowrey Hobba, all as tenants in common.

9. The said Lot 103, Section 15, of the Treasure Lake Subdivision owned by Jean M. Herr was subject to a tax sale by the Tax Claim Bureau of Clearfield County, Pennsylvania on September 18, 1987 for unpaid taxes.

10. By deed dated November 13, 1987 and recorded in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of Clearfield County in Deed Book 1194, page 243, the Tax Claim Bureau of Clearfield County, Pennsylvania conveyed Lot 103, Section 15, of the Treasure Lake Subdivision to Harry L. Mowrey and Florence A. Mowrey, husband and wife, and Patrick H. Mowrey and Kim Mowrey Hobba, all as tenants in common.

11. By deed dated January 6, 1988 and recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Clearfield County in Deed Book 1203, page 399, Harry L. Mowrey and Florence A. Mowrey, husband and wife, and Patrick H. Mowrey and Kim Mowrey Hobba, conveyed Lot 103, Section 15 and Lot 104, Section 15 to John Gus Manos and Doris Graham Manos, husband and wife, as tenants by the entirety (an undivided one-half interest), and John Graham Manos and Sandy Hay Manos, husband and wife, as tenants by the entirety (an undivided one-fourth interest), and David Fuller Manos and Joan C. Manos, husband and wife, as tenants by the entirety, (an undivided one-fourth interest).

12. Jean Herr died in or about 1981 in Butler County, Pennsylvania. A Decree of Distribution was filed purportedly transferring the interest of Jean M. Herr to John Herr and Richard Herr. The Decree of Distribution of Real Estate is recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds in Volume 1009 at page 483.

13. By Deed dated January 15, 1988 and recorded in the Office of Recorder of Deeds in Deed Book 1735, page 593, John Herr conveyed his interest in Lot 103, Section 15, in the Treasure Lake Subdivision to John G. Manos and Doris G. Manos, husband and wife, as tenants by the entirety, a one-half interest, John Graham Manos, a one-fourth interest, and David Fuller Manos, a one-fourth interest, with the one-half interest in each individual one-fourth interest being held as joint tenants with the right of survivorship between such interests. This is the same premises which Treasure Lake of Pennsylvania, Inc. conveyed to Jean M. Herr, widow, by deed

dated May 15, 1978 and recorded in the Clearfield County Recorder of Deeds Office in Volume 764, page 182. Said Deed was given to remove any cloud upon such tax title which may exist because of interest of John Herr.

14. By deed dated January 16, 1996 and recorded in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of Clearfield County in Deed Book 1735, page 597, Doris G. Manos, a/k/a Doris Graham Manos, widow, John Graham Manos and Sandy Hay Manos, husband and wife, and David Fuller Manos and Joan C. Manos, husband and wife, granted both Treasure Lake Lot 103, Section 15, and Treasure Lake Lot 104, Section 15, to Scott Krise and Natalie Krise, husband and wife.


15. The purpose of this action is to quiet the title on both Treasure Lake Lot 103, Section 15, and Treasure Lake Lot 104, Section 15, as to any interest the Defendants Jean M. Herr, Richard Herr and Carl F. Heitmeyer and Wanda K. WHEREFORE, the Plaintiff's request the Court to decree that title to the premises described herein be granted unto Plaintiffs in fee simple and absolutely; and that the Defendants, their heirs, devisees, executors, administrators, and assigns, and all other person, persons, firms,

partnerships, or corporate entities in interests, or their legal representatives be forever barred from asserting any right, lien, or interest inconsistent with the interest or claim of the Plaintiffs as set forth herein, in and to the property described in paragraph two (2).


