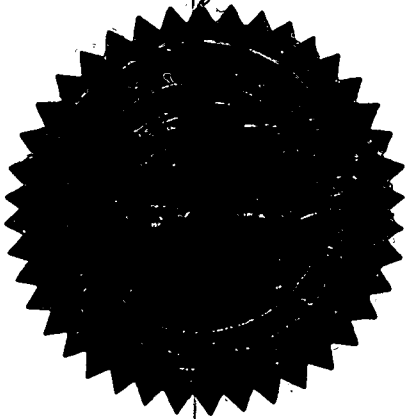
To the Honorable the Judges of the

Of June Session 1869
The petition of the Commissioners of
the said County of Charles
Respectfully sheweth,

That two dis-
cussive Grand Jurors of the said
County have reported in favor of the
erection of a new Jail therein, that said
report has been approved by your Hon-
orable Court, that the said Commissioners
have agreed upon a plan for the
erection thereof as is shown by the
sketch hereto annexed; that the funds
in the County Treasury are not sufficient
for the defrayal of the expenses attending
the erection of the same, and that they
intend to raise the money necessary therefor
by issuing the bonds of the County therefor
to an amount not exceeding the sum of

Eighty thousand dollars
dollars, under the provisions of the act
of the General Assembly approved April
9, 1868, and in pursuance of the require-
ments of the said act they now append
hereto as required by said act, a statement
of the financial condition of the ~~Subscribers~~ said

County and they respectfully pray that
 the said Court will approve their
 action in issuing bonds and in making
 the loan aforesaid for the purpose
 of erecting the said Jail

And now June 29, 1869, the foregoing petition having been read and ~~considered~~, and it appearing that two successive grand juries of the County have reported in favor of the Erection of a new Jail, which report has been approved by the Court of Quarter Sessions of said County, and it further appearing by a presentation to the Court of a statement of the financial Condition of the County, that the funds on hand in the County treasury will not be sufficient to defray the necessary expenses of the Erection of said new Jail, the Court hereby approves of a loan being made by the Commissioners of the County of the sum of Eighty thousand dollars, to defray the necessary expenses of the building and Erection of said new Jail, and the said Commissioners are hereby authorized to borrow the said sum of Eighty thousand dollars, and issue the bonds of the County of昌平 full charge, in amounts not less than fifty dollars, with coupons attached, at a rate of interest not exceeding six per centum. Said bonds to be payable not more than ten years from date, and to be exempt from taxation for all local and Municipal purposes.
