**PETITION FOR REVIEW**


AND NOW comes Petitioner, Ronald M. Marshall, by and through Ronald L. Collins, Esquire, who Petitions your Honorable Court as follows:

1. That Petitioner is Ronald M. Marshall, Operator License No. 24794372, of RD #2, Box 152, Ridge Road, Mahaffey, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, 15757.
2. That Respondent is the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation.
3. That by two (2) official notices both dated March 20, 2002, Petitioner's operating privileges were suspended by Respondent in connection with Petitioner's Summary Convictions for two (2) offenses of Driving Under Suspension, 75 Pa. C.S.A. §1543 (a) occurring in Indiana County, Pennsylvania. Both convictions occurred in Indiana County on March 12, 2002 and were Citation Nos. A4906787-4 and A5632932-4. The first offense is alleged to have occurred on May 13, 2001, and the second offense is alleged to occurred on October 8, 2001. Copies of said Notices are hereinafter attached as Exhibits "A" and "B"
4. That Petitioner has filed Notices of Appeal of both of said Summary Convictions in Indiana County and also motions for leave to file those appeals nunc pro tunc. Those appeals and motions are currently pending in Indiana County.
5. That if said Summary Convictions are vacated on appeal, Respondent will no longer have

a basis upon which to suspend Petitioner's operating privileges for these offenses.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests your Honorable Court to review the actions of Respondent in suspending Petitioner's operating privileges based on the ultimate result of said appeals filed in Indiana County.




