ROAD VIEWERS.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield in and for said county, on the 29 day of June, A. D. 1869, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Bradford, in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from Andrew Peters

to a point on the old State Road on or near
the line between Joseph Miller and
John Peters

Report of as to damages

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

James Mitchell, George Wilson, & Jacob Barges
who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the

shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

To the Honorable the Judges of the Court of
Quarter Sessions of the Peace in and for the
County of Clearfield. We the persons appointed
by the within order of Court to view and lay
out the road therein mentioned do report
That after giving due public notice of the time
and place of meeting, We met agreeably thereto
on the 6th day of September A.D. 1869 and after
being duly sworn according to law we proceed-
ed to view and layout and do now return
for Private use the following road to wit
Beginning at a point on line between Joseph Miller
and Andrew Peters thence through land of Joseph Miller
S 46° E along an old road 11.6 per to hemlock thence S 56½° E
48.1 per to small maple on line between John Peters
and Joseph Miller thence on said line S 43¼° W 98 per to
Township road known as an old State road
We also further report that the owners of the land
of which the above laid-out road passes through were
present and were willing that there should be no damages
assessed to them

To the Honorable the Judges of the Court of
Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the Co. of Clearfield.

The petition of Andrew Peters, Isaac Wilson & John
Peters, Respectfully represents:

That they labor under inconvenience from want of a
road from the premises of said Andrew Peters in
Bradford Township to a point in the highway known
as the Old State road, on or near the line between the
premises of Joseph Miller and said John Peters in the
township aforesaid. They therefore pray the Court
to appoint three persons, qualified according to law,
to view the place where said road is requested, and
make report of their proceedings to the said
Court at the next term thereof.
