ORDINANCE NO. 2002-10

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF SHAW STREET FROM AN ALLEY TO PALMER STREET IN LAWRENCE TOWNSHIP, CLEARFIELD COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

WHEREAS, all of the owners abutting the portion of Shaw Street between an Alley and Palmer Street of Lawrence Township have petitioned the Lawrence Township Supervisors to vacate Shaw Street between an Alley and Palmer Street; and

WHEREAS, the Lawrence Township Supervisors have given public notice and the owners adjacent to Shaw Street ten (10) days written notice of the hearing that was held on March 19, 2002 at 2:15 p.m. to inquire into the merits of vacating Shaw Street from an Alley to Palmer Street;

AND WHEREAS, the hearing was held and no one appeared to object to said action.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED:

1. That Shaw Street be and it is hereby vacated and closed between an Alley and Palmer Street of Lawrence Township and removed from the Township road system.

2. The Lawrence Township Secretary is directed to record this Ordinance together with the attached draft of the alley being vacated in the Prothonotary's Office of the Court of Common Pleas, of Clearfield County.

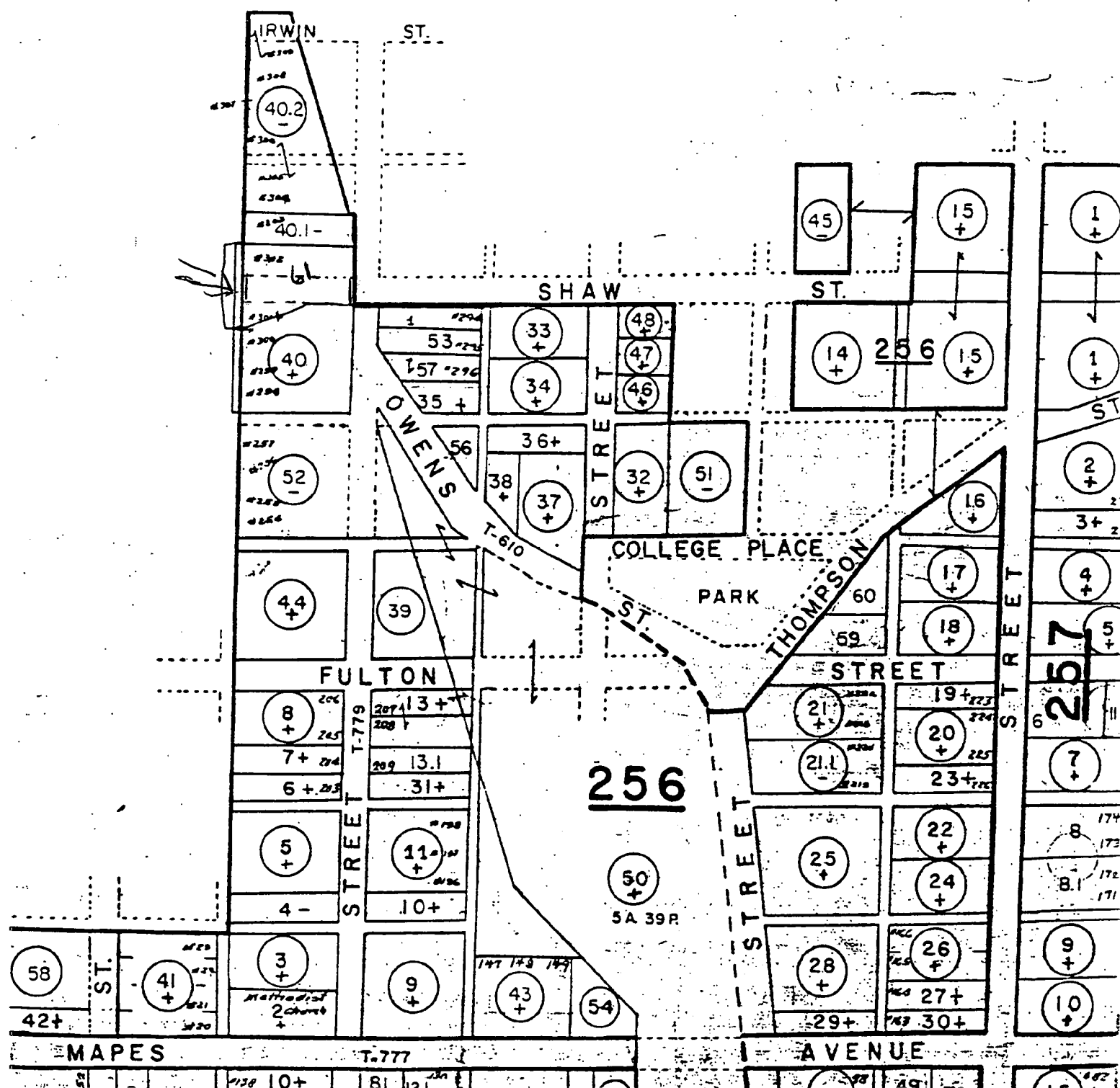
