





1. That the Plaintiffs, Robert E. Mellott and Lisa L. Mellott are husband and wife, residing at 305 Winesap Drive, Port Matilda, Pennsylvania, 16870.

2. That the Defendant, William C. Jones is deceased, and there is no estate of record in the Register of Wills Office of the County of Clearfield.

3. That the Defendant Laverna Wilson, a daughter of William C. Jones; is deceased, and there is no estate of record in Clearfield County.

4. That the Defendant, Elizabeth Williams is believed to be deceased , but the names and whereabouts of her heirs are unknown, with the exception of one child believed to be known as James Williams.

5. That the whereabouts of defendant James Williams, and whether he is living or deceased, is unknown to the plaintiffs.

6. That the defendant David P. Creighton is an adult individual whose last known address is 515 Ida Street, Philipsburg, Pennsylvania.

14. That the defendant Wendy Thorn Shields is an adult individual whose last known address is 1580 Philadelphia street, Indiana, Indiana County, Pennsylvania.

15 That the defendant Randall L. Thorn is an adult individual whose last known address is P.O. Box 64, Kittanning, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania.

16. That the defendant Geraldine W. Hubler is an adult individual who resides at RR 1, Box 350, Clearfield, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania

17. That the defendant Martha Edmiston is believed to be deceased, and the names and whereabouts of her heirs, if any, are unknown to the Plaintiffs.

18. That the defendant William Neidrich, Jr. is believed to be deceased, and the names and whereabouts of his heirs, if any, are unknown to the Plaintiffs.

19. That the Plaintiffs are in possession of a parcel of land situate in the Township of Lawrence, County of Clearfield, State of Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows:

PARCEL ONE: BEGINNING at a post on an alley and corner of Lot No. 52 formerly owned by John Carter, thence by said lot South 68 degrees West two hundred (200) feet ; thence along the township road or street South 22 degrees East fifty (50) feet

to corner of lot No. 54; thence by same North 68 degrees East two hundred (200) feet to an alley; thence along same, North 22 degrees West fifty (50) feet to the place of beginning. It being known and numbered as Lot No. 53 in the plan of the Spackman Addition to the Village of Glen Richey.

PARCEL TWO: Two lots adjoining the above and known and numbered as lots No. 54 and 55 in the same village as above and bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a corner of Lot No. 53, thence by same North 68 degrees East two hundred sixteen (216) feet to an alley; thence by said alley South 22 degrees East one hundred (100) feet to an alley; thence by said alley South 68 degrees West two hundred nineteen (219) feet to a post near the Township Road; thence by same North 20 degrees West one hundred (100) feet to the place of beginning. Containing one-half acre.

BEING identified in the Office of Mapping and Assessment as Map no. 123-J11-13.

PARCEL THREE:

Beginning at a point at the intersection of two alleys; thence South 22 degrees East along western line of said alley 100 feet more or less to a point; thence South 68 degrees West 220 feet more or less to a point on the Township Road; thence along said Township Road North 22 degrees West 100 feet more or less to an alley; thence along line of alley, North 68 degrees East a distance of 219 feet to a point and place of beginning.

BEING identified in the Office of mapping and Assessment as Map No. 123-J11-13.

20. That William Neidrick, Jr. acquired title to parcels One and Two as described in Paragraph 19 by a deed dated March 4, 1913 from Annie Morgan and Thomas Morgan recorded March 4, 1913 in Deed Book 201 Page 35, said deed incorporated herein by reference thereto.

21. That taxes were unpaid for the year 1929 and the County Treasurer sold the premises to the Clearfield County Commissioners by a deed dated February 9, 1932 and recorded October 14, 1935 in Deed Book 311 Page 223. That the Clearfield County Commissioners sold the property to Martha Edmiston by a deed dated September 16, 1935 recorded October 14, 1935 in Deed Book 311 Page 225, said deeds incorporated herein by reference thereto.

22. That taxes were unpaid for the year 1938 and the County Treasurer sold the premises to the Clearfield County Commissioners by a deed dated May 5, 1941 and recorded January 15, 1952 in Deed Book 361 Page 541.. That the Clearfield County Commissioners sold the property to William S. Wilson and Laverna Wilson by a deed dated May 29, 1943 recorded January 14, 1952 in Deed Book 361 Page 345, said deeds incorporated herein by reference thereto.

23. That the parcels have been assessed in the names of William S. Wilson and Laverna Wilson since the year 1949.

24. That the premises described as Parcel No. 3 in Paragraph 19 consisted of a house and lot and was assessed in the name of William C. Jones from 1889 to 1944 when the assessment was changed to the William C. Jones, Estate. In 1960 the assessment was changed to the William C. Jones, Heirs and is currently being assessed to the William C. Jones, Heirs.

25. That no estate has been filed in the name of William C. Jones and that Laverna Wilson is his only known heir known to plaintiff. That Laverna Wilson was intermarried with William C. Wilson who died testate July 22, 1970, his estate filed to No. 70-298 in the Register of Wills Office of Clearfield County. That under the terms of his will dated October 11, 1957 and filed in Will Book 16 Page 227 all of the residue of his estate vested in his children, Elizabeth Williams, Agnes Thorn, Hugh Wilson, William Wilson, Ruth Nolan, John Everett Wilson and Eleanor Davis, said records incorporated herein by reference thereto.

26. That Eleanor Jean Davis died testate August 27, 1994, her estate filed to No. 1994-516 in the Register's Office of Clearfield County. Under the terms of her will dated

January 18, 1994 and filed in Will Book 83 Page 174, all of the residue of her estate vested in David P. Creighton, said records incorporated herein by reference thereto.

27. That Ruth Nolan is believed to be deceased and survived by two children, Eleanor Nolan and John Nolan whose whereabouts are unknown to the plaintiff.

28. That Agnes Thorn died June 30, 1981 survived by her husband, Robert Thorn, and three children, Joann Mellott, Marilyn Aughenbaugh and William T. Thorn. That Robert Thorn died intestate, August 29, 1992, his estate filed to No. 1992-454 in the Register of Wills Office of Clearfield County.

29. That Joanne T. Mellott and her husband Augustus E. Mellott conveyed all of their interest in the premises described in Paragraph 19 to Robert E. Mellott and Lisa L. Mellott by a deed dated May 1, 2002 recorded May 1, 2002 as Document No. 200206908, said deed incorporated herein by reference thereto.

30. That William T. Thorn died testate December 16, 1992, his estate filed to No. 1992-589 in the Register of Wills Office of Clearfield County. Under the terms of his will dated August 31, 1992, all of his estate vested in his three children, William T. Thorn, II, Wendy Thorn Shields and Randall L. Thorn, and Geraldine W. Hubler, defendants herein.

31. That Agnes Thorn, grandmother, and Robert Thorn, grandfather, and Robert E. Mellott maintained the premises and paid all real estate taxes for a period in excess of twenty-one years.


WHEREFORE, the plaintiffs respectfully request:

a) That the defendants, their heirs and assigns and any other person claiming under them, and all other persons having a claim to the premises described herein, be ordered to bring an action of ejectment to establish their claim to the premises described
