PETITION FOR LEAVE TO COMPROMISE MINOR'S ACTION

AND NOW, comes Lynette Heichel, mother of Adam Albright, by and through her attorneys, the Law Offices of Richard H. Milgrub, by Brian K. Marshall, Esquire, who file the following Petition:

1. That Lynette Heichel is the mother of Adam Albright, a minor, who was born on February 3, 1992, and was injured as a result of an incident on October 18, 2001.
2. That Raymond Albright is the father of Adam Albright.
3. That the Moshannon Valley Pharmacy is a business operating in the Ames Plaza, Route 322 West, Philipsburg, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, 16866.
4. That on October 8, 2001, the defendant, the Moshannon Valley Pharmacy, dispensed a prescription drug in the name of Adam Albright to Lynette Heichel, mother of the minor child, Adam Albright. The amount dispensed was approximately

ten (10) times the prescribed amount, and was in a liquid form, rather than tablet form that had been originally prescribed.

5. That the Moshannon Valley Pharmacy did not counsel Lynette Heichel, mother of the minor child, Adam Albright, on the fact that there was significantly more liquid dispensed than the amount of medication called for in the prescription for one (1) tablet of said medication.

6. That the minor child, Adam Albright, ingested all ten (10) doses of the liquid form of the medication, and thereafter had a severe reaction.

7. That as a result of overdosing on said medication, the minor child was life-flighted from the Philipsburg Hospital where he was initially treated to Conemaugh Medical Center in Johnstown, where he received medical treatment for several days.

8. That all medical bills incurred by Your Petitioner have been paid by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania which does have a subrogation interest in the amount of One Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-nine and 79/100 (\$1,139.79) Dollars.

9. That counsel is retained on a one-third (1/3) contingency fee basis by Your Petitioner and has incurred the following expenses:

- a) FYI Healthserve (records) \$ 30.83
- b) Recordex Acquisition Corp (records) \$ 77.93
- c) William A. Shaw, Prothonotary (filing fee) \$ 80.00

TOTAL ----- \$188.76

10. That counsel and Your Petitioner recommend the approval of a settlement in the gross amount of Eight Thousand (\$8,000.00) Dollars negotiated with the defendant.

11. That Your Petitioner approves the proposed settlement because she feels that it is fair and reasonable and that it adequately compensates for the injuries sustained.

WHEREFORE, Your Petitioner prays that an Order be entered approving the compromise, allowing counsel fees, and order distribution.


