

**COMPLAINT IN EQUITY AND PETITION
FOR PERMANENT INJUNCTION**

AND NOW, this 19th day of July, 2002, comes the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania acting by Attorney General D. Michael Fisher, through the Bureau of Consumer Protection, and brings this action pursuant to the Unfair Trade Practices and Consumer Protection Law, Act of December 17, 1968, P.L. 1224, as amended and re-enacted by the Act of November 24, 1976, P.L. 1166, No. 260, the Act of December 3, 1996, 73 P.S. §201-1, *et seq.*, (hereinafter referred to as the "Consumer Protection Law"). The Consumer Protection Law authorizes the Attorney General to bring an action in the name of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to restrain by temporary and/or permanent injunction, unfair methods of competition or unfair or deceptive acts or practices in the conduct of any trade or commerce declared unlawful by §201-3 of the Consumer Protection Law. In support of this action the Commonwealth respectfully represents the following:

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

8. Defendant established Bloom's Home Improvements as a sole proprietorship on or before May 1, 2001.

9. The Defendant advertised for sale, offered for sale and sold residential home improvement services to consumers located within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, including consumers within Clearfield County. A true and correct copy of the business card that the Defendant used in advertising Bloom's Home Improvements is attached hereto and labeled Exhibit "A".

10. The Defendant entered into contracts for residential home improvement services with consumers as a result of, or in connection with, a contact with or call upon the consumers at the consumers' residences in person (hereinafter referred to as "home improvement contracts").

11. Defendant entered into home improvement contracts with consumers which were signed in the consumers' homes.

12. The Defendant has accepted payments for residential home improvement services in connection with said home improvement contracts.

13. After entering into home improvement contracts and accepting payment from consumers for home improvement services the Defendant failed to perform any home improvement services or, in the alternative, failed to fully complete the home improvement services provided for in said home improvement contracts.

14. Pennsylvania consumers, including consumers in Clearfield County, have suffered losses as a result of the Defendant's unfair and deceptive acts and practices. Consumers harmed by Defendant's practices include, but are not limited to, Mr. and Mrs. Jerry L. Smith of R.D. 2, Box 176, Morrisdale, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, consumers over the age of sixty (60) who entered into a home improvement contract with the Defendant on September 28, 2001, which provided for the Defendant to remove old shingles and reshingle their home. The Smiths paid the Defendant \$3,200.00 of the \$5,400.00 contract price on September 28, 2001, and Defendant was to promptly begin

1 work on the Smith's house. On October 19, 2001, Defendant ordered materials for the
2 Smiths' house but never performed any home improvement services on the Smiths' house.
3 The Defendant paid for some of the materials for the Smith roofing job, however, as a
4 result of his failure to perform the Smiths have suffered losses in the amount of \$2,262.79.
5 A true and correct copy of the contract between Defendant and the Smiths and a receipt
6 evidencing the Smith's payment to the Defendant is attached hereto and labeled Exhibit
7 "B".

8
9 **COUNT I**

10 **CONSUMER LAW VIOLATIONS**

11 15. Paragraphs 1 through 14 of the foregoing complaint are incorporated
12 herein by reference.

13 16. The Defendant entered into home improvement contracts with consumers,
14 accepted payment for home improvement services to be performed and then failed to
15 perform any home improvement services or, in the alternative, failed to fully complete the
16 home improvement services provided for in said home improvement contracts and as a
17 result consumers have suffered losses equal to the amount they have paid for home
18 improvement services which were not performed or were not fully completed.

19 17. The Defendant has contracted to perform home improvement services for
20 residential consumers which were not completed in a good and workmanlike manner and
21 as a result consumers have suffered losses in connection with the completion or repair of
22 the project that was the subject of their home improvement contract.

23 18. The Defendant falsely represented to consumers that he had insurance
24 coverage or other benefits that he did not have.

25 19. The acts, practices and methods of competition set forth above are unlawful
26 and in violation of the Consumer Protection Law in that they constitute unfair methods of
27 competition and unfair or deceptive acts or practices in the conduct of trade or commerce

1 as defined by §201-2(4)(ii), (iii), (v), (vii), (ix), (xi), (xiv), (xvi), and (xxi) of the Consumer
2 Protection Law.

3 20. Defendant has caused and continues to cause irreparable harm by violating
4 the Consumer Protection Law and, therefore, the Commonwealth requests the relief set
5 forth in the Prayer for Relief below.

6
7 **COUNT II**

8 **DEFENDANT USES ILLEGAL CONTRACTS**

9 21. Paragraphs 1 through 14 of the foregoing complaint are incorporated herein
10 by reference.

11 22. Defendant has used contracts which violate the provisions of §201-7(b)(1)
12 and (2) of the Consumer Protection Law and the Federal Trade Commission Rule
13 concerning a Cooling-Off-Period for Door-To-Door Sales, 16 C.F.R. §429, 37 Fed.Reg. No.
14 22934, by failing to include the required notice of cancellation in the contract itself and by
15 not using the notice of cancellation form required to be attached to such contracts.

16 23. The Defendant has used contracting practices which violate the provisions
17 of §201-7(d) of the Consumer Protection Law by having failed to orally inform consumers
18 at the time they sign contracts of their right to cancel.

19 24. The acts, practices and methods of competition set forth above are unlawful
20 and in violation of the Consumer Protection Law in that they constitute unfair methods of
21 competition and unfair or deceptive acts or practices in the conduct of trade or commerce
22 as defined in §201-2(4)(xxi) of the Consumer Protection Law.

23 25. Defendant has caused and continues to cause irreparable harm by
24 violating the Consumer Protection Law and, therefore, the Commonwealth requests the
25 relief set forth in the Prayer For Relief below.

1 **PRAYER FOR RELIEF**

2 WHEREFORE, the Commonwealth respectfully requests this Honorable Court
3 to issue an Order:

4 A. Permanently enjoining the Defendant from engaging in the aforementioned
5 acts, practices, methods of competition or any other practice violative of the Consumer
6 Protection Law or other state law;

7 B. Directing Defendant to permanently forfeit his right to engage in trade and
8 commerce within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania by entering into any home
9 improvement contracts either individually, through any person acting on his behalf, as a
10 partner, or through any corporate or business device;

11 C. Directing the Defendant to make full restitution to all consumers who
12 suffered losses as the result of Defendant's business practices as alleged in this complaint;

13 D. Directing the Defendant to pay civil penalties in the amount of One Thousand
14 and 00/100 Dollars (\$1,000.00) for each and every violation of the Consumer Protection
15 Law, which will increase to Three Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$3,000.00) for each
16 violation involving a victim age 60 or older;

17 E. Directing the Defendant to pay the Commonwealth for the costs of its
18 investigation and prosecution of this action; and,


19 F. Providing such other equitable relief as the Court may deem appropriate
20 and necessary.

**PETITION FOR RULE TO SHOW CAUSE WHY
CONTEMPT SANCTIONS SHOULD NOT ISSUE**

AND NOW, this 30th day of July, 2003, comes the Petitioner, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, acting by Attorney General D. Michael Fisher, and brings this Petition for Rule to Show Cause Why Contempt Sanctions Should Not Issue against Paul E. Bloom, individually, and d/b/a Bloom's Home Improvement pursuant to §§201-8, 201-9 and 201-9.1 of the Act of December 17, 1968, P.L. 1224, as amended and re-enacted by the Act of November 24, 1976, P.L. 1166, No. 260, and the Act of December 4, 1996, P.L., No. 146, 73 P.S. §201-1 *et seq.* (hereinafter referred to as the "Consumer Protection Law"), and in support thereof respectfully represents the following:

1. The Petitioner is the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, acting by Attorney General D. Michael Fisher, through the Bureau of Consumer Protection, Ebensburg Regional Office (hereinafter referred to as the "Commonwealth"), 171 Lovell Avenue, Suite 202, Ebensburg, Pennsylvania.
2. Respondent Paul E. Bloom is an adult individual whose last known address is P.O Box 344, Bigler, Pennsylvania.
3. At all times material hereto Respondent Paul E. Bloom personally

1 participated in all of the actions alleged herein.

2 4. On April 8, 2003, an Order was issued by the Clearfield County Court of
3 Common Pleas providing that Respondent Paul E. Bloom:

4 (A) was directed to make restitution totaling Two Thousand Two
5 Hundred Sixty-two and 79/100 Dollars (\$2,262.79) to Mr. and
6 Mrs. Jerry L. Smith and judgment shall be entered against him
7 in this amount;

8 (B) was enjoined from collecting any amounts due on the contracts
9 which he had entered into with Mr. and Mrs. Joseph DeCasper
10 and Mr. and Mrs. Supenia;

11 (C) was directed to pay the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania a civil
12 penalty in the amount of Five Thousand and 00/100 Dollars
13 (\$5,000.00) and judgment shall be entered against him in this
14 amount;

15 (D) was directed to pay the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania costs
16 in the amount of One Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$100.00)
17 and judgment shall be entered against him in this amount;

18 (E) was to begin making monthly payments on May 5, 2003,
19 toward satisfaction of the judgment entered in an amount equal
20 to ten percent (10%) of his gross monthly income for the month
21 preceding the payment of the same and shall include with each
22 payment a statement itemizing all income received in the prior
23 month;

24 (F) was enjoined from engaging in trade and commerce within the
25 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as the provider of home
26 improvement contracting services until the judgments entered
27 against him have been satisfied in full; and,

28 (G) was permanently enjoined from engaging in any acts, practices

1 or method which violate the Unfair Trade Practices and
2 Consumer Protection Law.

- 3 5. On April 25, 2003, the Commonwealth provided the Respondent with a copy
4 of the Court's Order of April 8, 2003, and a letter outlining his payment
5 obligations. This letter informed the Respondent that his first monthly
6 installment payment representing the month of April was due by May 5,
7 2003, along with a statement itemizing all income that he received for that
8 month.
- 9 6. The Respondent did not submit either his payment of ten percent (10%) of
10 his gross monthly income for April or a statement itemizing all income that
11 he received for that month by May 5, 2003, as required by the Court's Order.
- 12 7. On May 28, 2003, the Commonwealth sent the Respondent a second letter
13 stating that his first required payment was not received and requesting that
14 he send this initial payment along with his next scheduled payment which
15 was due by June 5, 2003. The Respondent failed to send the payments and
16 the required statements itemizing all the income received for the months of
17 April and May by June 5, 2003.
- 18 8. On June 23, 2003, the Commonwealth sent the Respondent a third letter
19 notifying him that his payments for May 5, 2003, and June 5, 2003, were not
20 received and requesting that he submit those payments along with his next
21 scheduled payment which was due by July 7, 2003. The Respondent again
22 failed to send the payments and the required statements itemizing all the
23 income received for the months of April, May and June by July 7, 2003.
- 24 9. As of the date of this Petition for Rule to Show Cause Why Contempt
25 Sanctions Should Not Issue the Respondent has failed to make any
26 payments, send any statements itemizing his income or make any attempt
27 to contact the Commonwealth to discuss this matter.
- 28 10. The Commonwealth is informed, believes and therefore avers that the

1 Respondent has willfully violated this Court's Order dated April 8, 2003, by
2 failing to begin making his monthly payments and by failing to provide the
3 Commonwealth with statements itemizing all income he has received.

4 11. Respondent's violations of the Order of April 8, 2003, is sufficient cause to
5 hold the Respondent in contempt of court.

6 12. The Commonwealth believes that the public interest is served by seeking to
7 reopen this proceeding and to hold Respondent Paul E. Bloom in contempt
8 of court and, if necessary, to enforce this Court's Order pursuant to
9 Pa.R.C.P. No. 1529(c) by directing that Respondent Paul E. Bloom be
10 incarcerated until such time as he purges himself of contempt of this Court's
11 Order.

13 **PRAYER FOR RELIEF**

14 **WHEREFORE**, the Commonwealth respectfully prays this Honorable Court to issue
15 a Rule upon Respondent Paul E. Bloom: (a) to show cause why the Commonwealth is not
16 entitled to the relief requested herein; (b) to provide the Commonwealth with an accounting
17 of all income he has received from April 1, 2003, to the date of this Rule, supported by all
18 documentation evidencing all income received within this time period; and, (c) to schedule
19 a hearing on said Rule. Further, after a hearing on said Rule, the Commonwealth
20 respectfully prays this Honorable Court to enter an Order:

21 A. Citing Respondent Paul E. Bloom for contempt of court for failure to comply
22 with this Court's Order of April 8, 2003;

23 B. Directing that Respondent Paul E. Bloom be incarcerated until such time that
24 he purges himself of contempt by paying ten percent (10%) of his gross
25 monthly income since the entry of this Court's Order of April 8, 2003;

26 C. Assessing an additional civil penalty of Five Thousand and 00/100 Dollars

PETITION FOR CONTEMPT

The Plaintiff, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, by Attorney General Thomas W. Corbett, Jr., brings this Petition for Contempt against Defendant Paul E. Bloom pursuant to § 201-8 and § 201-9.1 of the *Unfair Trade Practices and Consumer Protection Law*, 73 P.S. § 201-1, *et seq.* (hereinafter referred to as the "Consumer Protection Law") and in support thereof respectfully represents the following:

1. Plaintiff is the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, by Attorney General Thomas W. Corbett, Jr., through the Bureau of Consumer Protection, Ebensburg Regional Office, 171 Lovell Avenue, Suite 202, Ebensburg, Pennsylvania 15931 (hereinafter "Commonwealth").
2. Defendant Paul E. Bloom is an adult individual whose current or last known address is 708 Decater Street, Chester Hill, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania (hereinafter "Defendant").
3. At all times material hereto Defendant has personally participated in all of the actions alleged herein.

BACKGROUND

4. On July 22, 2002, the Commonwealth filed a Complaint in Equity and Petition for Permanent Injunction (hereinafter "Complaint") against the Defendant, who was doing business at that time as Bloom's Home Improvements.
5. The allegations in the Complaint include, but are not limited to, the following violations of the Consumer Protection Law: accepting payments for work to be performed and then failing to fully complete the work, failing to perform home improvement services in a good and workmanlike manner, falsely representing to consumers that he had insurance coverage or other benefits that he did not have; and, failing to provide consumers with notice of their cancellation rights.
6. Judgment by Default was entered against the Defendant and on March 26, 2003, a hearing was held to assist the Court in its adjudication and framing of a final decree.
7. On April 8, 2003, the Court entered an Order providing, *inter alia*, that:
 - A. The Defendant shall pay Mr. and Mrs. Jerry L. Smith restitution totaling Two Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-two and 79/100 Dollars (\$2,262.79);
 - B. The Defendant shall pay the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania civil penalties and costs in the amount of Five Thousand One Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$5,100.00);
 - C. Judgment be entered against the Defendant in the amount of Seven Thousand Three Hundred Sixty-two and 79/100 Dollars (\$7,362.79) representing the total amount he owed for consumer restitution, civil penalties and costs;
 - D. The Defendant shall pay on the judgments by making monthly installment payments in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of

his gross monthly income with his first payment due on May 5, 2003;

E. The Defendant is permanently enjoined from engaging in trade and commerce within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as the provider of home improvement contracting services either individually, through any person acting on his behalf, as a partner in any business entity, or through any corporate or business device until the judgments entered pursuant to this Order have been satisfied by payment in full; and,

F. The Defendant is hereby permanently enjoined from engaging in any acts, practices or methods of competition which violate the Unfair Trade Practices and Consumer Protection Law.

A copy of this April 8, 2003, Order is attached hereto and labeled Exhibit "A".

8. On July 31, 2003, a Petition for Rule to Show Cause Why Contempt Sanctions Should Not Issue (hereinafter "Petition for Rule to Show Cause") was filed against the Defendant for his failure to make payments as provided for in the Court's April 8, 2003, Order.
9. A hearing on the Commonwealth's Petition for Rule to Show Cause was scheduled for September 11, 2003, and on that date this Court entered an Order finding the Defendant in Contempt of Court and directing that the Defendant: keep the Commonwealth advised of any changes in his address until all amounts due are paid in full, submit the names of five (5) employers with whom he sought employment with the week before to the Department of Probation Services, Adult Division, every Monday morning; and, once employed, submit to a wage attachment and maintain such until any and all amounts due have been paid in full. A copy of this Order is attached hereto and labeled Exhibit "B".

10. To date the Commonwealth has not received any payments toward the judgments entered pursuant to this Court's April 8, 2003, Order.
11. The Commonwealth made several attempts to collect the amount owed pursuant to the Court's April 8, 2003, Order, including sending letters to the Defendant and contacting the Clearfield County Department of Probation Services to determine whether the Defendant was submitting the names of his prospective employers.
12. The Defendant has not made any payments toward the amounts owed pursuant to the Court's April 8, 2003, Order resulting in Mr. and Mrs. Jerry L. Smith, victims identified in the Commonwealth's original Complaint, never receiving restitution for the Defendant's violations of the Consumer Protection Law.

CURRENT BUSINESS PRACTICES

13. Based upon information received, the Commonwealth believes and, therefore, avers that the Defendant, who is now doing business as Bloom Contracting, not only continues to do business as a home improvement contractor in violation of this Court's April 8, 2003, Order, but also he continues to engage in business practices in violation of the Consumer Protection Law.
14. The Commonwealth is informed, believes and, therefore, avers that the Defendant is advertising home improvement services by displaying signs in Clearfield and Centre Counties including Morrisdale and Phillipsburg.
15. The Commonwealth is informed, believes and, therefore, avers that the Defendant has been advertising home improvement services by leaving his business card at consumers' homes. Attached hereto and labeled Exhibit "C" is a copy of the Defendant's business card.

16. The Commonwealth is informed, believes and, therefore, avers that the Defendant entered into home improvement contracts with David Kyler on July 20, July 24, and August 4, 2007, to perform home improvement services. Copies of these contracts are attached as Group Exhibit "D".

VIOLATIONS OF THIS COURT'S ORDERS

17. The Commonwealth is informed, believes and, therefore, avers that the Defendant has violated § 201-7(b)(1) and (2) of the Consumer Protection Law and paragraph 8 of this Court's April 8, 2003, Order by failing to include the required notice of cancellation in Mr. Kyler's contracts and by not using the notice of cancellation form required to be attached to such contracts.
18. Paragraph 7 of this Court's April 8, 2003, Order provides "Defendant Paul E. Bloom is permanently enjoined from engaging in trade and commerce within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as the provider of home improvement contracting services either individually, through any person acting on his behalf, as a partner in any business entity, or through any corporate or business device until the judgments entered pursuant to this Order have been satisfied by payment in full by Defendant Paul E. Bloom."
19. The Commonwealth is informed, believes and, therefore, avers that the Defendant has violated paragraph 7 of this Court's Order dated April 8, 2003, by entering into home improvement contracts with David Kyler.
20. The Commonwealth is informed, believes and, therefore, avers that the Defendant has violated this Court's September 11, 2003, Order by failing to keep the Commonwealth advised of any changes in his address and by failing to submit the names of five (5) employers with whom he has sought employment to the Department of Probation Services, Adult Division, on every Monday morning. Attached as Exhibit "E" is a copy of a letter from the

Clearfield County Department of Probation Services confirming that the Defendant failed to submit employment information every Monday morning.

21. The Defendant's actions display a renewed and blatant disregard for this Court's April 8, 2003, and September 11, 2003, Orders.
22. Further sanctions, including incarceration for indirect criminal contempt, are called for in order to preserve the dignity of this Honorable Court and to provide adequate protection for consumers who have been, and may be, victimized by the Defendant's past actions.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, the Commonwealth respectfully prays this Honorable Court to schedule a hearing on this matter and, after said hearing find the Defendant in contempt of this Court's April 8 and September 11, 2003, Orders, and thereafter:

- A. Cite the Defendant for indirect criminal contempt of court for failure to obey this Court's Orders;
- B. Order the Defendant to undergo incarceration for a period of time to be set by this Court, as may be allowed by law;
- C. If necessary, issue a bench warrant directing the appropriate law enforcement officer to detain the Defendant pending further hearing and to deliver him to said hearing;
- D. Direct the Defendant to pay additional civil penalties in the amount of Five Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$5,000.00) per violation due to his willful violations of this Court's Orders, as authorized by § 201-8 of the Consumer Protection Law;
- E. Direct the Defendant to pay all amounts owed to the Commonwealth under the April 8, 2003, Order; and,
- F. Grant any other relief as the Court may deem necessary and appropriate.
