COMPLAINT

AND NOW come plaintiffs, Robert Patton and Sheila Patton, by and through their counsel, Christopher P. Deegan, Esquire and Weber Gallagher Simpson Stapleton Fires & Newby LLP, and file the following Complaint:

1. Plaintiffs, Robert Patton and Sheila Patton (hereinafter referred to as "the Pattons"), are individuals residing at 20 Piney Lane, DuBois, Pennsylvania 15801.
2. Defendant, Sysco Corporation t/d/b/a Sysco Food Services of Jamestown (hereinafter referred to as "Sysco"), is a corporation doing business at P.O. 160 Jamestown, New York 14702.
3. Defendant, Robert Marquart (hereinafter referred to as "Marquart"), is an individual residing at 7037 Main Street, Cherry Creek, New York 14723.
4. At all times relevant hereto Robert Patton was operating a 1995 Ford Explorer owned by the Pattons.
5. At all times relevant hereto, Marquart was an employee and/or representative and/or agent of Sysco.
6. At all times relevant hereto, Marquart was operating a 2001 Mack truck with New

York license number 6318P8 and was acting within the scope of his employment and/or representation and/or agency.

7. On or about August 21, 2001, Robert Patton was traveling east on Shaffer Drive in DuBois, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

8. Robert Patton had stopped in the right lane of Shaffer Drive at the red light at the intersection with Route 255.

9. After the light had turned green, Robert Patton proceeded into the intersection and, suddenly without warning, was struck by Marquart.

10. Marquart had been traveling south on Route 255 and failed to obey a red light.

11. At all times relevant hereto, Robert Patton was proceeding with caution, had the right-of-way, and attempted to avoid the collision.

12. As a result of the aforementioned accident, the damages suffered by the Pattons and the expenses related thereto include, but are not limited to, the following:

- a. Severe damage to their vehicle;
- b. Expenses associated with the towing and storage of the damaged vehicle;
- c. Inconvenience of not having a vehicle for 20 days.

COUNT I - NEGLIGENCE

Robert Patton and Sheila Patton v. Roger Marquart

13. Paragraphs 1 through 12 are incorporated herein as if set forth in full.

14. The careless, negligent and reckless conduct of Marquart was the direct and proximate cause of the damages suffered by the Pattons and that conduct is more particularly set forth below:

- a. In failing to watch the road in front of his vehicle;
- b. In not looking or watching where his vehicle is being operated;
- c. In operating his vehicle in a manner which caused it to strike the Pattons' vehicle;
- d. In failing to stop at a red light;
- e. In failing to watch the roadway as he approached the intersection;
- f. In failing to yield the right-of-way to Robert Patton;
- g. In failing to recognize that Robert Patton had control of the intersection;
- h. In failing to use his brakes or braking mechanisms;
- i. In traveling at an unsafe speed;
- j. In failing to take evasive action to avoid striking the Pattons' vehicle;
- k. In operating his vehicle in a reckless, careless and negligent manner;
- l. In operating his vehicle in violation of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code;
- m. In failing to provide the Pattons with the standard of care owed to them under the existing circumstances.

WHEREFORE, plaintiffs Robert Patton and Sheila Patton demand judgment in their favor and against the defendant Roger Marquart in the amount of \$10,439.90, exclusive of interest and costs.

COUNT II - NEGLIGENCE

Robert Patton and Sheila Patton v. Sysco Corporation t/d/b/a Sysco Food Services of Jamestown


15. Paragraphs 1 through 14 are incorporated herein as if set forth in full.
16. The careless, negligent and reckless conduct of Sysco's employee and/or representative and/or agent, Roger Marquarat, was the direct and proximate cause of the damages suffered by the Pattons and that conduct is more particularly set forth below:
 - a. In failing to watch the road in front of his vehicle;
 - b. In not looking or watching where his vehicle is being operated;
 - c. In operating his vehicle in a manner which caused it to strike the Pattons' vehicle;
 - d. In failing to stop at a red light;
 - e. In failing to watch the roadway as he approached the intersection;
 - f. In failing to yield the right-of-way to Robert Patton;
 - g. In failing to recognize that Robert Patton had control of the intersection;
 - h. In failing to use his brakes or braking mechanisms;
 - i. In traveling at an unsafe speed;
 - j. In failing to take evasive action to avoid striking the Pattons' vehicle;
 - k. In operating his vehicle in a reckless, careless and negligent manner;
 - l. In operating his vehicle in violation of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code;
 - m. In failing to provide the Pattons with the standard of care owed to them under the existing circumstances.
17. The careless, negligent and reckless conduct of Sysco is the direct and proximate cause of damages suffered by the Pattons and the conduct is more particularly set forth below:

- a. In failing to properly train its employees and/or representatives/and or agents;
- b. In failing to supervise its employees and/or representatives and/or agents;
- c. In permitting those employees and/or representatives and/or agents to act or omit to act as described in Paragraphs 14 and 16 above;
- d. In failing to provide the Pattons with the standard of care owed to them under the existing circumstances.

WHEREFORE, plaintiffs Robert Patton and Sheila Patton demand judgment in their favor and against the defendant Sysco Corporation t/d/b/a Sysco Food Services of Jamestown in the amount of \$10,439.90, exclusive of interest and costs.

ANSWER, NEW MATTER AND COUNTERCLAIM

AND NOW, come the defendants, Sysco Corporation t/d/b/a Sysco Food Services of Jamestown ("Sysco") and Roger Marquart ("Marquart"), by and through its counsel, Bryan J. Smith, Esquire, and Dell, Moser, Lane & Loughney, L.L.C., and files the following Answer, New Matter and Counterclaim to Plaintiffs' Complaint, and in support thereof as follows:

ANSWER

1. Upon information and belief, the allegations contained in paragraph 1 of the Complaint are admitted.

2. The averments contained in paragraph 2 of the Complaint are denied as stated.

To the contrary, Sysco Food Services of Jamestown is a division of Sysco Corporation.

3. The averments contained in paragraph 3 of the Complaint are admitted.

4. Upon information and belief, the averments contained in paragraph 4 are admitted.

5. The averments contained in paragraph 5 are admitted.

6. The averments contained in paragraph 6 are admitted.

7. The averments contained in paragraph 7 of the Complaint are denied as stated. To the contrary, it is believed and therefore averred that the vehicle operated by Robert Patton ("Patton") was traveling on State Route 4017, when the Patton vehicle suddenly and abruptly made a right-hand turn onto State Route 255 colliding with the vehicle operated by Defendant Marquart.

8. The averments contained in paragraph 8 of the Complaint are denied pursuant to Pa.R.C.P. 1029(e).

9. The averments contained in paragraph 9 of the Complaint are denied pursuant to Pa.R.C.P. 1029(e). To the contrary, the traffic signal controlling traffic on State Route 4017 at the time Patton made his right-hand turn was red. Thus, Patton traveled through a red light while the signal controlling the traffic on State Route 255 was green. Therefore, Defendant Marquart proceeded through the green light.

10. The averments contained in paragraph 10 of the Complaint are admitted in part and denied in part. It is admitted Marquart was traveling south on Route 255. The remaining allegations are denied pursuant to Pa.R.C.P. 1029(e). To the contrary, Marquart had a green light as he proceeded through the intersection.

11. The averments contained in paragraph 11 of the Complaint set forth conclusions of law to which no response is required. In the event it is determined a response is required, the averments are denied pursuant to Pa.R.C.P. 1029(e). To the contrary, at all times relevant hereto, Patton operated his vehicle in a careless, reckless, and negligent manner by, inter alia, traveling through a red light.

12. The averments contained in paragraph 12 of the Complaint and subparagraphs 12 (a)-(c) set forth conclusions of law to which no response is required. In the event it is

determined a response is required, it is denied that any acts and/or omissions of defendants caused and/or contributed to the accident in question, or any alleged damages.

COUNT I – NEGLIGENCE

Robert and Sheila Patton v. Roger Marquart

13. In response to the averments contained in paragraph 13 of the Complaint, defendants incorporated paragraphs 1 through 12 of this Answer as if set forth at length herein.

14. The averments contained in paragraph 14 of the Complaint set forth conclusions of law to which no response is required. In the event it is determined that a response is required, the averments are denied pursuant to Pa.R.C.P. 1029(e). To the contrary, the accident was caused by the careless, negligent, and reckless conduct of Patton in, inter alia, failing to obey the red light controlling his lane of travel.

15. In response to the averments contained in paragraph 15 of the Complaint, defendants incorporated paragraphs 1 through 14 of this Answer as if set forth at length herein.

16. The averments contained in paragraph 16 and subparagraphs 16 (a)-(m) of the Complaint are denied pursuant to Pa.R.C.P. 1029(e). To the contrary, the subject accident was caused by the careless, negligent, and reckless conduct of Patton in, inter alia, failing to obey the traffic signal controlling his lane of travel.

17. The averments contained in paragraph 17 and subparagraphs 17 (a)-(d) set forth conclusions of law to which no response is required. In the event it is determined a response is required, the averments are denied pursuant to Pa.R.C.P. 1029(e). To the contrary, the subject accident was caused by the careless, negligent, and reckless conduct of Patton in, inter alia, failing to obey the traffic signal controlling his lane of travel.

WHEREFORE, Defendants, Sysco Corporation t/d/b/a Sysco Food Services of Jamestown and Roger Marquart, demand that judgment be entered in their favor against plaintiffs.

NEW MATTER

By way of further answer, Sysco and Marquart assert the following as new matter:

18. The Complaint fails to state a cause of action against Sysco and Marquart upon which relief can be granted.

19. The subject accident was caused by the careless, negligent, and reckless conduct of Robert Patton in, inter alia, traveling through a red light.

20. The plaintiff's claims are barred in whole or in part by the provisions of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Financial Responsibility Law which are pled herein as an affirmative defense.

21. Alternatively, plaintiffs claims are barred and/or limited by the contributory negligence of the plaintiff Robert Patton, and the provisions of the comparative negligence statute which is pled herein as an affirmative defense.

COUNTERCLAIM

AND NOW, come defendants, Sysco Corporation t/d/b/a Sysco Food Services of Jamestown and Roger Marquart, by and through their attorneys Bryan J. Smith, Esquire and Dell, Moser, Lane & Loughney, L.L.C., and states the following in support of its counterclaim against the plaintiff's as follows:

COUNT I
Negligence

22. Paragraphs 1 through 21 are incorporated by reference as if set forth at length herein.

23. At all times relevant hereto, Marquart was proceeding with caution and had a green light as he traveled through the intersection of State Route 255 and State Route 4017.

24. As a result of the accident, the damages sustained by the defendants and expenses related thereto include, but are not limited to, the following:

- (a). Damage to the Sysco vehicle in the amount of \$5,834.70; and
- (b). Expenses associated with towing and storage of the damaged vehicle;

25. The careless, negligent and reckless conduct of Robert Patton was the direct and proximate cause of the damages sustained by defendants.

26. The direct and proximate cause of the accident was the careless, negligent, and reckless conduct of Patton including, but not limited to, the following particulars:

- (a). In failing to stop at a red light;
- (b). In traveling into the intersection in disregard of the red light controlling Patton's lane of travel;
- (c). In failing to watch the road in front of his vehicle;
- (d). In not watching where he was operating his vehicle;
- (e). In failing to watch the roadway as he approached the intersection;
- (f). In failing to yield the right-of-way to Roger Marquart;
- (g). In failing to observe that Roger Marquart had control of the intersection;
- (h). In failing to take evasive action to avoid striking Marquart's vehicle;
- (i). In operating his vehicle in violation of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code;
- (j). In operating his vehicle in a reckless, careless, negligent manner;
- (k). In failing to provide Marquart with the standard of care owed to him under the existing circumstances.

WHEREFORE, defendants demand judgment against plaintiff in the amount of \$5,834.70, plus costs, interest, and attorneys fees.
