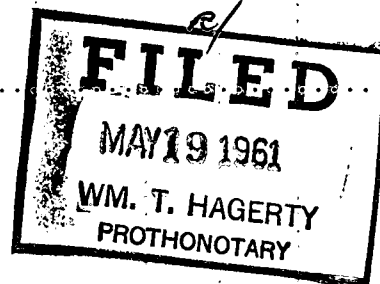

and says as follows:

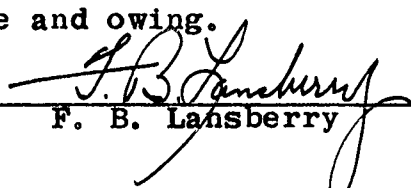
(1). That he is Vice President and Cashier of The County
