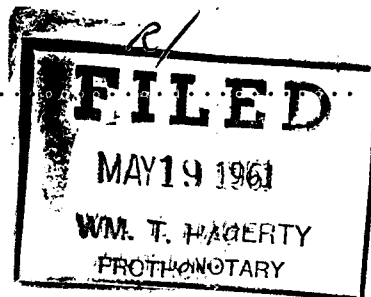

(\$396.32) Dollars for collection.


(3). That said obligation is past due and in default.
