COMPLAINT

COMES NOW, ROLAND G. TIRACORDA, by its attorney, Peter F. Smith and avers the following:

1. The Plaintiff's full name is **ROLAND G. TIRACORDA**, and he resides at P.O. Box 456, Madera, Pennsylvania, 16661.

2. The name of the first Defendant is **B. F. CHASE, JR.**, whose last known address and present whereabouts are unknown to the Plaintiff.

3. The name of the second Defendant is **MARTIN WITHEROW**, whose current whereabouts and last known address are unknown to the Plaintiff.

4. By deed dated December 31, 1937 H.F. Bigler, Jr. Treasure of Clearfield County sold the premises subject to this action for unpaid taxes to the Clearfield County Commissioners. Said deed is recorded at Clearfield county Deed Book 353, page 480 and conveys 66 acres in Jordan Township assessed in the name of B.F. Chase, Jr.

5. It is believed and therefore avered that **B.F. CHASE, JR.** purchased the premises at prior a tax sale that named **MARTIN WITHEROW** as the owner, but do to a malfunction in the Clearfield County microfilms system, Plaintiff's agents are unable to discover how **MARTIN WITHEROW** obtained title to the premises.

6. There is no deed of record in Clearfield County for the premises to **B. F. CHASE, JR.**, and specially no deed to him from Martin Witherow.

7. **B.F. CHASE, JR.**, died February 7, 1934 and Letters Testamentary were issued to his widow **RHODA MAE CHASE** at Clearfield County Estate No. 15415.

8. The Estate proceedings of **B.F. CHASE, JR.**, state that he was survived only by his widow and had no children.

9. The estate proceedings of **B.F. CHASE, JR.**, do not identify the premises subject to this action as an asset of his estate. However, a petition in the estate does indicate that his widow and executrix was in possession of a number of unrecorded deeds at the time of his death.

10. It is believed that **RHODA MAE CHASE** has since died. However, no estate proceedings have been opened for her in Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

11. By deed dated August 23, 1943 and recorded in Clearfield County Deed Book 353, Page 481 the Clearfield County Commissioners conveyed the premises subject to this action identified and described as 66 acres in Jordan Township sold as the property of **B. F. CHASE, JR.** to **J. S. REITZ** and **A. H. REITZ**.

12. J. S. REITZ was also known as JOSEPH S. REITZ. He died on October 13, 1950. His last Will and Testament is of record in Clearfield County Will Book Y page 24, in which he divides all his real property to his surviving spouse ANNA H. REITZ also known as A. H. REITZ.

13. By deed dated October 21, 1958 and recorded in Clearfield County Deed Book 470, page 597 on October 21, 1958 A. H Reitz conveyed the premise subject to this action to the Plaintiff ROLAND G. TIRACORDA.

14. Plaintiff's deed to the premises subject to this action describes the premises as follows:

ALL that certain piece or parcel of land situate in Jordan Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania bounded and described as follows, to wit:

Bounded on the north by C.B.C. Corporation and Snyder Bloom; bounded on the east by Clyde Bloom Estate and Dave Witherow; bounded on the south by Dave Witherow and bounded on the west C. V. Strong. Containing sixty-six acres more or less.

BEING the premises conveyed to J.S. and A.H. Reitz, by deed of the Clearfield County Commissioners, in May 1943.

EXCEPTING AND RESERVING however from the above described premises all oil and gas in, upon, under said premises, together with the right on behalf of the Grantor, her heirs or assigns, or lessee's, to go upon the said premises for the purpose of drilling for the producing oil and gas thereinunder, without liability as to any damages to surface, crops or timber.

15. Plaintiff and his predecessors in title have been in open, notorious, hostile, adverse and continuous possession, dominion and control of the premises for period exceeding 21 years.

16. The first purpose of this Quiet Title Action is to cure

any defect in the record of this title and to extinguish any estate, equity, rights, claims or interests which the Defendants, their heirs, successors and assigns may have in the **PREMISES**.

17. The second purpose of this Quiet Title Action is to cure any defects, errors or omissions in this title arising from its sale of the **PREMISES** for delinquent taxes by the Clearfield County Tax Claim Bureau.


WHEREFORE, Plaintiff requests:

A. That this Honorable Court decree that Plaintiff is the true, lawful and only owner of the premise described in paragraphs 12 and 13 above;

B. That defendants, within 30 days of receipt of this Complaint, institute action of ejectment against the Plaintiffs and that if they fail to do so the Defendants be perpetually enjoined from setting up any title or a claim to the premises subject to this action from impeaching, denying or in any way attacking the Plaintiff's title to the premises subject to this action, from issuing or maintaining an ejectment from said premises and from encumbering, mortgaging, leasing, conveying or otherwise attempting to transfer an interest in the premises or any part thereof; and

C. Such other relief as the court may determine to be equitable.



5. I have examined telephone directories for Clearfield and surrounding communities. I found no listing for **B.F. CHASE, JR.**


6. I have examined telephone directories for Clearfield and surrounding communities. I found no listing for **MARTIN WITHEROW**.

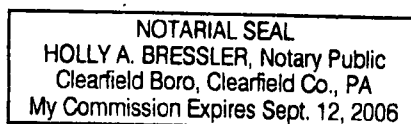




