




3. By the terms of the Court January 27, 2003 Order, the requested relief would be granted without a hearing if the Defendant did not respond.





AND NOW, comes the Plaintiff, DuBrook, Inc, by and through its attorneys, DILLON McCANDLESS KING COULTER & GRAHAM, L.L.P., per Ronald T. Elliott, Esquire, and files the following Motion to Reinstate Judgment Against a Party based upon the following:

1. Dubrook, Inc. ("Plaintiff") is a Pennsylvania Corporation with a mailing address of P.O. Box 68, Butler, Pennsylvania 16003.

2. On or about July 25, 2002, Plaintiff commenced an action against Creative Concrete which has a mailing address of 5 East Second Avenue, DuBois, Pennsylvania 15801.

3. Plaintiff had previously filed a Motion to Correct a Name of a Party alleging that Creative Concrete is a fictitious name for Richard Blose.

4. After more recent investigation, Plaintiff has learned that Creative Concrete, Inc. is a Pennsylvania Corporation with an address of 5 East Second Avenue, DuBoise, Pennsylvania 15801.

5. Creative Concrete, Inc. had applied for credit with Plaintiff on or about February 6, 2002. As part of that credit application, Richard J. Blose granted a personal guarantee for any debts due Plaintiff from Creative Concrete, Inc. A copy of the credit application and the personal guarantee is attached hereto, incorporated herein, and marked Exhibit A.

6. By previous Order, your Honorable Court Ordered that the caption of the case be corrected to: Dubrook, Inc., Plaintiff, v. Richard Blose, Defendant.

7. By Order dated April 2, 2003 your Honorable Court issued an Order amending the caption to indicate that Richard Blose was a Defendant and that judgment in the amount of \$2,678.19 be entered in favor of Plaintiff and against Richard Blose.

8. Because Creative Concrete, Inc. is a Pennsylvania Corporation and the original Defendant in this case, Creative Concrete, Inc. should also be named as a Defendant with the Judgment of \$2,678.19 entered against both Creative Concrete, Inc. and Richard Blose, individually.
