C O M P L A I N T

NOW COMES, the Plaintiffs, and by their Attorney, John R. Ryan, Esquire, and sets forth a claim against the Defendants named herein as follows:

1. Plaintiff are:

a. Mark L. Irwin, an individual, residing at R.R. 1, Box 211A, West Decatur, Pennsylvania, 16878.

b. Thomas M. Irwin, an individual, residing at 903 Arbor Street, Philipsburg, Pennsylvania, 16866.

2. The Defendant is Ross Lambert, an individual who is believed to be deceased, his heirs, successors, executors, administrators, and assigns, as well as any other person, persons,

firms, partnerships, or corporate entities who might claim any title to the premises herein described.

3. The property involved in this action is described as follows:

ALL that certain piece or parcel of ground located in Boggs Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, consisting of approximately three hundred (300) acres, being Assessment Map Numbers 105-L9-45.

4. The premises which are the subject of this Action to Quiet Title became vested in Ross Lambert by virtue of two deeds:

a. Deed from D.R. Fullerton, Clerk of the Orphans' Court in and for Clearfield County, dated December 18, 1892, and recorded on July 14, 1894 in Deed Book Volume 83, Page 398.

b. Deed from Jane Ralston and Thomas Ralston, her husband dated March 5, 1890 and recorded on March 14, 1892, in Clearfield County Deed Book Volume 69, Page 91.

5. The said premises were exposed at Treasurers' Sale as property of Ross Lambert on November 9, 1937 for nonpayment of real estate taxes for the years 1932, 1933, and 1935. The Treasurer of Clearfield County sold seated land identified as property of Ross Lambert to the Clearfield County Commissioners by virtue of a deed dated December 31, 1937 and recorded on February 18, 1944 in Clearfield County Deed Book Volume 352, Page 533.

6. By virtue of a Commissioners' Tax Sale held on April 23, 1943, the Clearfield County Commissioners sold and conveyed the same premises to A.R. Chase, John Haney, Mildred D. Shaw, and Walter M. Swoope by deed dated August 23, 1943 and recorded on February 18, 1944 in Clearfield County Deed Book Volume 352, Page 535.

7. Plaintiffs acquired title to the above-described premises by virtue of two deeds:

a. Deed dated April 27, 2001 from F. Cortez Bell, Jr., Attorney in Fact for Miriam C. Chew, David Mosely Welch, Daniel Chase Welch, John C. Harvey, Anne H. Mustienes, Jane Severin, Elizabeth N. Sweetow, formerly known as Elizabeth N. McDougall, Walter M. Swoope, Jr., Hester H. Lippert, Arnold B. Shaw, III, and Sandra Ann Shaw DeCasper, formerly Sandra Ann Shaw; and County National Bank as Executor for the Marie Mitchell Estate; and Anna E. Dougherty, Trustee of the Anna E. Dougherty Trust, recorded at Clearfield County Instrument Number 200109404.

b. Deed dated August 22, 2001 from Suzanne C. Love and Jesse E. Love, her husband, and Michael W. Chew and Marisa Chew, his wife, recorded at Clearfield County Instrument Number 200115642.

8. The above-referenced Grantors are the heirs, devisees, and assigns of the said A.R. Chase, John Haney, Mildred D. Shaw, and

Walter M. Swoope who purchased the subject premises at Commissioners' Tax Sale as set forth in Paragraph 6 herein above.

9. Plaintiffs, through their predecessors in title, have acquired title to the above described premises through the above-mentioned deeds and also by more than twenty-one (21) years adverse possession of said property. Said possession having been open, notorious and adverse to all interests which the Defendant may have had in the premises.

10. Plaintiffs, through their predecessors in title, made adverse entry on the above-described property commencing in 1944, approximately fifty-eight (58) years ago, and said adverse possession has continued until the present time. Plaintiffs adverse possession of the property through their predecessors in title has been open, continuous, exclusive and notorious in character and has continued for more than the statutory period of twenty-one (21) years, it having been adverse to all interests which the Defendant herein may have in the premises.

11. This Action to Quiet Title is necessary in order to firmly vest title in the Plaintiffs through the chain of deeds and by adverse possession, and also to clear any defects in title which may have arisen through the tax sale. There are often unknown defects at tax sales which are not clearly apparent on the record. It is intended that any defects in title which may be present can be brought up at this time. It is the purpose of this action to

give all parties the opportunity to present any claim they might have to the property.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs bring this Action to Quiet Title and ask the court to decree as follows:

a. That the Plaintiffs are seized of an indefeasible title as acquired through the deeds recited herein above and also by adverse possession to the premises situated in Boggs Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania;

b. Enter such judgment or other relief which may be necessary in establishing an indefeasible title in the Plaintiffs;






4. That the Plaintiffs have an indefeasible title to the property which has Assessment Map Number 105-L9-45. Title to be indefeasible as against all of the above described premises.
