1. That the Plaintiff is TMP Company, Inc., a Pennsylvania corporation having a place of business located at Graham Street, Hyde, Pennsylvania 16843.

2. That the Defendant, E.B.S. Restaurant Equipment, Inc. (hereinafter known as E.B.S.), is a North Carolina corporation, having a place of business located at 1750 Lawson Street, Durham, North Carolina 27702.

3. That the Defendant, Mark Herman, is an adult individual, whose address is 1750 Lawson Street, Durham, North Carolina 27702.

4. That at all times referred to herein, the Plaintiff, TMP Company, Inc., engaged in the business of

manufacturing box coolers and related equipment in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

COUNT I

5. That Paragraphs 1 through 4 of this Complaint and incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.

6. That on or about October 28, 1999, Defendant E.B.S. requested a quote from Plaintiff to manufacture a cooler/freezer combination, walk-in cooler with accessories and panels to convert existing cooler into two separate coolers.

9. That the contract for the equipment manufactured by Plaintiff for Defendant E.B.S. was made and accepted at Plaintiff's principle place of business located at Graham Street, Hyde, Pennsylvania 16843.

10. That in reliance upon the contract referred to in Paragraph 9, which is incorporated herein by reference, Plaintiff manufactured and shipped to Defendant the cooler/freezer combination, walk-in cooler with accessories, and panels to convert the existing cooler into two separate coolers identified in the specifications attached hereto as Exhibit "B".

11. That Defendant E.B.S. received the said cooler/freezer combination, walk-in cooler with accessories and panels by common carrier on or about December 10, 1999, and February 3, 2000.

12. That Defendant E.B.S. has failed to pay Plaintiff for the cooler/freezer combination, walk-in cooler with accessories and panels although demand for payment has been made.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff claims damage from the Defendant E.B.S. in the amount of \$16,190.74 with interest as allowable by law.

COUNT II

13. That Paragraphs 1 through 12 of this Complaint are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.

14. That Defendant Mark Herman in his individual capacity requested Plaintiff to manufacture and ship to Defendant TRS a cooler/freezer combination, walk-in cooler with accessories and panels as described in the specifications attached hereto as Exhibit "B".



6. That on or about October 28, 1999, Defendant E.B.S. requested a quote from Plaintiff to manufacture a cooler/freezer combination, walk-in cooler with accessories and panels to convert existing cooler into two separate coolers.

7. That in compliance with said request, Plaintiff provided Defendant E.B.S. with a quote totaling \$16,190.74.

8. That Defendant E.B.S. accepted Plaintiff's quote by fax directed to Plaintiff's principle place of business located at Graham Street, Hyde, Pennsylvania 16843.

9. That the contract for the equipment manufactured by Plaintiff for Defendant E.B.S. was made and accepted at Plaintiff's principle place of business located at Graham Street, Hyde, Pennsylvania 16843.

10. That in reliance upon the contract referred to in Paragraph 9, which is incorporated herein by reference, Plaintiff manufactured and shipped to Defendant the cooler/freezer combination, walk-in cooler with accessories, and panels to convert the existing cooler into two separate coolers.

11. That Defendant E.B.S. received the said cooler/freezer combination, walk-in cooler with accessories and panels by common carrier on or about December 10, 1999, and February 3, 2000.

12. That Defendant E.B.S. has failed to pay Plaintiff for the cooler/freezer combination, walk-in cooler with accessories and panels although demand for payment has been made.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff claims damage from the Defendant E.B.S. in the amount of \$16,190.74 with interest as allowable by law.

COUNT II

13. That Paragraphs 1 through 12 of this Complaint are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.


