PETITION FOR APPEAL FROM ORDER

SUSPENDING DRIVER'S LICENSE

Now, comes Appellant, Joann Maureen Caliari, by and through her attorneys, The Hopkins Law Firm, and avers as follows:

1. Appellant is Joann Maureen Caliari residing and having a mailing address at Laura Lane, R.R. #1, Box 161A, Penfield, PA 15849.

2. Appellee herein is the Department of Transportation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, having a mailing address of Department of Transportation, Bureau of Driver Licensing, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17123.

3. By letter or notice dated December 9, 2002, a copy of which is attached hereto labeled Exhibit "A", the Department of Transportation ordered Appellant to surrender her operators license for a period of ninety (90) days.

4. The said suspension of Appellant's operating privileges is improper or unlawful for the following reasons:

a. The suspension is not supported by the law;

b. Appellant was convicted of a violation of compulsory attendance requirement by District Magistrate Patrick Ford on November 18, 2002. Appellant has appealed said conviction to the Court of Common Pleas of Clearfield County on December 17, 2002 and the Denovo Hearing has yet to be heard.

c. The suspension is not supported by the facts in as much as the Appellant was not truant;

WHEREFORE, Appellant respectfully requests this matter be set down for a hearing before your Honorable Court and that the order of suspension be set aside.

Dear MS. CALIARI:

On 11/18/2002 you were convicted of Truancy under Section 1333 of the Public School Code. As a result, your driving privilege (or your right to apply for a driver's license) is being suspended for 90 DAY(S) as required by Section 1338.1 of the Public School Code.

In order to comply with this sanction you are required to return any current driver's license, learner's permit and/or temporary driver's license (camera card) in your possession no later than the effective date listed. If you cannot comply with the requirements stated above, you are required to submit a DL16LC Form or a sworn affidavit stating that you are aware of the sanction against your driving privilege. Failure to comply with this notice shall result in this Bureau referring this matter to the Pennsylvania State Police for prosecution under SECTION 1571(a)(4) of the Vehicle Code.

Although the law mandates that your driving privilege is under suspension even if you do not surrender your license, Credit will not begin until all current driver's license product(s), the DL16LC Form, or a letter acknowledging your sanction is received in this Bureau.

WHEN THE DEPARTMENT RECEIVES YOUR LICENSE OR ACKNOWLEDGEMENT, WE WILL SEND YOU A RECEIPT. IF YOU DO NOT RECEIVE THIS RECEIPT WITHIN 15 DAYS CONTACT THE DEPARTMENT IMMEDIATELY. OTHERWISE, YOU WILL NOT BE GIVEN CREDIT TOWARD SERVING THIS SANCTION.

The effective date of suspension is 01/20/2003, 12:01 a.m.

Approximately 30 days before your driving privilege is eligible for restoration, provided credit has begun on your suspension, you will receive a letter that identifies the steps you must follow for restoration of your driving privilege. When you receive the letter, please read it care-

fully and follow all the instructions. This will ensure timely restoration of your driving privilege.

Please see the enclosed application for restoration fee information.

APPEAL

You have the right to appeal this action to the Court of Common Pleas (Civil Division) within 30 days of the mail date, DECEMBER 16, 2002, of this letter. If you file an appeal in the County Court, the Court will give you a time-stamped certified copy of the appeal. 
ORDER FOR SUPERSEDEAS
