
1. The Petitioner, TIMOTHY MAHUTE, is an adult individual, who currently resides at R.D. #1, Box 269, Junitata Avenue, Houtzdale, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, 16651.
2. The Respondent is the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation, whose address is Office of Chief Counsel, Third Floor, Riverfront Office, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, 17104.
3. By Notice sent to the Petitioner on December 24, 2002, the Petitioner was advised that his driver's license privileges had been suspended by the Department of Transportation. Such revocation was based on a guilty verdict of resulting from exceeding the maximum speed limit. The Notice of suspension is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

4. Petitioner appeals this proposed suspension as he contests the aforementioned speeding tickets.

5. Consequently, if said tickets are eliminated or reduced, likewise said suspension would be dismissed.

6. Therefore, Petitioner requests an appeal of the proposed suspension by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner prays your Honorable Court to order the suspension imposed by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation, stayed and of no further effect in such manner that the Petitioner may continue to enjoy his driving privileges, until a full hearing is held on this matter.



Dear Motorist:

As a result of your conviction on 12/16/2002 of violating Section 3362 of the Vehicle Code, EXCEEDING MAXIMUM SPEED on 10/26/2002, your privilege to drive a commercial motor vehicle is being disqualified for a period of 60 DAY(S) as mandated by Section 1611G of the Vehicle Code.

The effective date of disqualification is 01/28/2003, 12:01 a.m.

In order to comply with this sanction you are required to return any current driver's license, learner's permit and/or temporary driver's license (camera card) in your possession no later than the effective date listed. If you cannot comply with the requirements stated above, you are required to submit a DL16LC Form or a sworn affidavit stating that you are aware of the sanction against your driving privilege. Failure to comply with this notice shall result in this Bureau referring this matter to the Pennsylvania State Police for prosecution under SECTION 1571(a)(4) of the Vehicle Code.

Although the law mandates that your driving privilege is under suspension even if you do not surrender your license, Credit will not begin until all current driver's license product(s), the DL16LC Form, or a letter acknowledging your sanction is received in this Bureau.

WHEN THE DEPARTMENT RECEIVES YOUR LICENSE OR ACKNOWLEDGEMENT, WE WILL SEND YOU A RECEIPT. IF YOU DO NOT RECEIVE THIS RECEIPT WITHIN 15 DAYS CONTACT THE DEPARTMENT IMMEDIATELY. OTHERWISE, YOU WILL NOT BE GIVEN CREDIT TOWARD SERVING THIS SANCTION.

While your commercial driving privilege is disqualified, the Vehicle Code permits a driver to obtain a noncommercial Class C or M license, if the driver possesses the motorcycle qualification, to drive noncommercial motor vehicles. If you wish to obtain this license, please complete the enclosed application as instructed and return it to the Department.

Please be aware that if you elect to obtain this noncommercial Class C or M license, you are still prohibited from operating a commercial motor vehicle. If you do so, you are subject to additional penalties, including possible lifetime disqualification of your commercial driving privilege.

You have the right to appeal the Department's action to the Court of Common Pleas (Civil Division) within 30 days of the mail date (DECEMBER 24, 2002) of this notice. You must still send in your license before the effective date of disqualification unless you appear in person before a Judge and receive an order permitting you to continue to drive. PLEASE NOTE that this Civil Appeal is in addition to any appeal you have to file from the criminal conviction.


