C O M P L A I N T

(1). The name of the Plaintiff is James T. Crissman, an individual having a place of business in Lawrence Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

(2). The name of the Defendant is Edward Toth, an individual who resides at 729 Camp Street, McKees Rocks, Pennsylvania.

(3). The Plaintiff at the special instance and request of the Defendant did repair/<sup>or move</sup> the following equipment, all of which was damaged and all of which was owned by the Defendant:- an auto car tractor, a 3500 Manitowac shovel, and a Lacross trailer. All of said repairs were performed in a workmanlike and competent fashion.

(4). All of said repairs were performed at a fair price and at a price agreed to by the Defendant.

(5). Subsequent to said repair, the Plaintiff at the request of the Defendant did move to Plaintiff's storage yard the tractor and trailer, and has stored the same since June, 1960.

(6). That a fair price for said storage is \$30.00 per month.

(7). Plaintiff has demanded payment of the sum due him for said services in the amount of \$726.60, and storage from June, 1960 to and including February, 1961, in the amount of \$270.00, but the Defendant has refused and neglected to pay the same, or any part thereof, notwithstanding said services were performed by the Plaintiff for the Defendant. A copy of the original books of entry of the Plaintiff is hereto attached and made a part hereof.

(8). The Defendant is not entitled to any offsets, credits, or other deductions, except as outlined on the attached exhibits, and the balance as shown on said exhibits remains due and payable.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff brings this action to recover from the Defendant for services rendered the sum of \$726.60, together with interest from March 10, 1960, and plus storage at the rate of \$30.00 a month from June, 1960 to and including February, 1961, in the amount of \$270.00, together with interest on the component parts.


