C O M P L A I N T

The Plaintiff, Albert Whitesell, complains of the Defendant, Tony Hosko, as follows:

1. The Plaintiff is an individual residing at R.D. LeContes Mills, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.
2. The Defendant, Tony Hosko, is a resident of 703 Elk Avenue, Clearfield, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.
3. On December 31, 1960, the Plaintiff was the owner of a 1950 Buick Sedan and was operating the same at or about 9:30 A.M. in an Easterly direction on Bridge Street at or near the intersection of Second Street, having stopped for the traffic light.
4. On the said date, the Defendant, Tony Hosko, was the operator of a 1958 Buick traveling also in an Easterly direction on Bridge Street in the Borough of Clearfield and crashed into the vehicle of the Plaintiff which was already stopped for the traffic light, causing damages thereto.
5. That in the operation of his vehicle, the Defendant was negligent in the following respects:

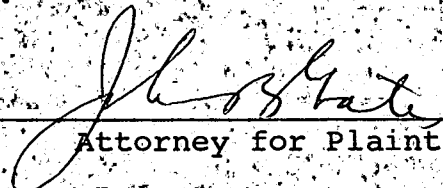
a. Driving too fast for conditions;

b. In not having his vehicle under proper control;

c. In failing to regard the lawful use of the highway by the vehicle of the Plaintiff.

6. That as a result of the negligence of the Defendant, the Plaintiff's vehicle was totally destroyed except for salvage value and that the value of the Plaintiff's vehicle prior to the accident, including the sales tax was \$350.00 and the value of the said vehicle after the accident for salvage purposes was \$50.00.

WHEREFORE the Plaintiff brings this suit to recover the sum of \$300.00 together with damages for delay in payment of the same from January 31, 1961.
