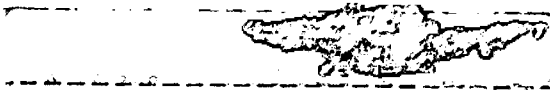

In Trespass

COMPLAINT

Now, this 13th day of November, 1961, come the Plaintiffs herein, and bring this action in trespass against the Defendant, William A. Selfridge, Jr., upon a cause of action whereof the following is a statement:

(1). The Plaintiffs are Donna Jeanne Zeigler, a minor, and her grandmother, Clara Seibert, who reside in Morrisdale, Morris Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

(2). At the time the events hereinafter set forth occurred, the Plaintiffs were the owners of a 1955 Oldsmobile four-door sedan.

(3). The Defendant is an adult resident of Winburne, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, and was at the time the events hereinafter set forth occurred, the owner and operator of a Mercury motor vehicle.

(4). On January 19, 1961, the Plaintiff, Donna Jeanne Zeigler, was operating her motor vehicle in a Westerly direction on the public highway running between Winburne and Munson in Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

(5). As Plaintiff reached a point approximately one-fourth mile west of Winburne, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, the Defendant, who was also operating his vehicle in a Westerly direction, between Winburne and Munson in Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, did come from Plaintiff's rear and did strike the rear end of Plaintiff's vehicle.

(6). The Defendant was negligent in the following manner:

- (a). in driving at an excessive speed considering driving conditions;
- (b). in failing to have his car under such control so as to be able to stop within the assured clear distance ahead;
- (c). in failing to take into consideration the rights of other lawful users of the highway and in particular, the rights of Plaintiffs herein;

(7). As a result of the negligence of the Defendant, Plaintiffs' motor vehicle was damaged and Plaintiffs were forced to expend the sum of \$157.04 as set forth in the copy of the repair bill attached hereto and made a part hereof.

(8). The amount claimed by the Plaintiffs is within the jurisdictional amount requiring arbitration in Clearfield County.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs ask judgment against the Defendant in a liquidated amount of \$157.04 plus interest from February 24, 1961 by reason of delay.

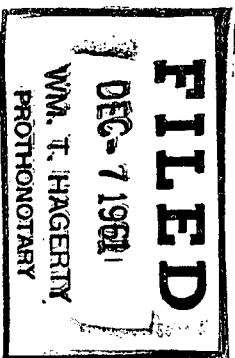

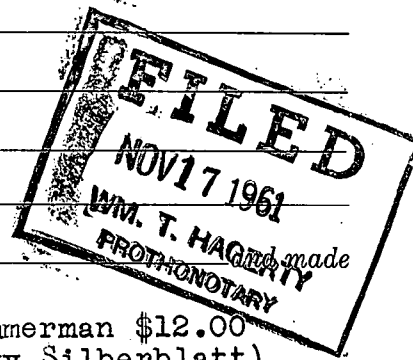
