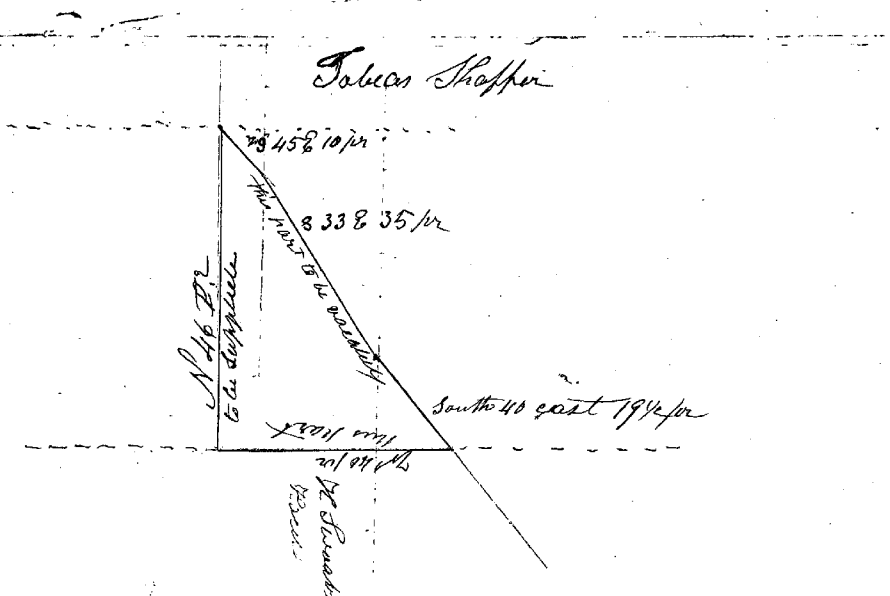

We the Subscribers R Luther Jacob Gilliom and
Jacob Yoas the persons appointed by the Said
Court to view evacuate and Supply a certain
portion and part of the road there in mentioned
do report that after having been Specially Sworn
and after having given ten day notice by written
notices have viewed the said Road to be evacua-
ted and are of the opinion that the said part first
named should be vacated and Supplied by the
last described piece namely Beginning at the
end of the lane of Tobias Shaffers on the Road
leading from Abram Meaders to Henry Reams
then South forty five degrees east ten perches
then South thirty three degrees east thirty five
perches then South forty degrees east nineteen perches
to line between Tobias Shaffer & Henry Swoole this
part to be vacated and Supplied by the following
Beginning at the last named place on line of Henry
Swoole and Tobias Shaffer then west along the same
line forty perches near said Henry Swoole house
then north forty six perches to Tobias Shaffers
lane to the beginning on the said Road leading
from C Meaders to H Reams the said Henry
Swoole agreeing ~~agree~~ to ~~open~~ open and make
the said new Supplied piece of Road and put it
in good order at his own expense a draft on plat of
which is here unto annexed Whereof our hands
and seals this 2^d day of April AD 1869

ROAD VIEWERS.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield in and for said county, on the 16 day of March, A. D. 1869, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Bloom & Brady, in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from Adam Weaver's ^{charge of} in Bloom Township to Henry Reams in Brady Township

Report as to damages &c

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to ^{vacate & supply} ~~view and lay out~~ the same according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Roswell Luther Jacob Gilliox & Jacob Yoas who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view ^{vacate and supply} ~~the ground~~ ^{vacation & supply} ~~properties~~ for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.
