COMPLAINT

AND NOW, comes the Plaintiff, by his attorneys, Dennison, Dennison & Harper, who file the following Complaint upon the cause of action, the following of which is a clear and concise statement:

1. Jason T. Bertothy, Plaintiff, is an individual of full age and sui juris who resides in Centre County, Pennsylvania, and has a post office address of 1761 Black Moshannon Road, Philipsburg, Pennsylvania.

2. William E. Broll, Jr., Defendant, is an individual of full age and sui juris who resides in Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, and has a post office address of P.O. Box 77, Bigler, Pennsylvania.

3. Wallace Transportation, Inc., Defendant, is a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and has a post office address of R. D. 1, Box 179, Woodland, Pennsylvania.

4. On April 1, 2002, and at all times material to this Complaint, Wallace Transportation, Inc., Defendant, was in the trucking and hauling business.

5. On April 1, 2002, and all times material to this Complaint, the Plaintiff was the owner and operator of a 1997 Peterbilt, Model 379, tractor which was towing a trailer which was also owned by the Plaintiff.

6. On April 1, 2002, and at all times material to this Complaint, the Defendant, William E. Broll, Jr., was the operator of a tractor-trailer unit.

7. On April 1, 2002, and at all times material to this Complaint, William E. Broll, Jr., Defendant, was employed as the agent, servant and workman of Defendant, Wallace Transportation, Inc., then and there engaged within the scope of his employment.

8. On April 1, 2002, the Plaintiff was operating his tractor which was hauling a trailer in a westerly direction on Interstate 80 in eastern Pennsylvania.

9. At the same time and place, the Defendant, William E. Broll, Jr. was operating a tractor-trailer unit in front of the Plaintiff's tractor.

10. The tractor-trailer unit which was being operated by the Defendant, William E. Broll, Jr., was hauling crushed automobiles.

11. Suddenly and without warning, debris fell from the tractor-trailer unit onto the traveled portion of Interstate 80 and struck the tractor and trailer owned by the Plaintiff, Jason T. Bertothy, which caused damages to them.

COUNT I

PLAINTIFF, JASON T. BERTOTHY vs. WILLIAM E. BROLL, JR., DEFENDANT

12. The averments of Paragraphs 1 through 11 of this Complaint are incorporated herein

by reference thereto as fully as the same are set forth above.

13. The damages caused to Plaintiff's tractor were caused by the negligence and carelessness of the Defendant, William E. Broll, Jr., and such negligence and carelessness consisted of the following:

- a. He failed to make certain that all parts of the crushed automobiles were properly secured prior to his driving on Interstate 80;
- b. He permitted loose objects to be located on the trailer which he was hauling which were then scattered onto the traveled portion of Interstate 80;
- c. He failed to properly inspect the trailer which he was hauling for loose objects;
- d. He operated the tractor-trailer at such a speed which caused loose objects to fall from the trailer he was hauling and land on Interstate 80;
- e. He operated the tractor-trailer at such a speed which caused objects to become dislodged from the crushed automobiles which were then scattered onto Interstate 80;
- f. He operated his vehicle without due regard to the safety and position of the Plaintiff's vehicle;
- g. He violated the provisions of 75 P.S. Section 3709 of the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

14. As a result of the negligence and carelessness of the Defendant, William E. Broll, Jr., as above described, the Plaintiff's Peterbilt tractor suffered damages, and the cost to repair these damages was Twelve Thousand Five Hundred Eighty-nine and 97/100 Dollars (\$12,589.97) as

set forth on an damage assessment which is attached hereto and is made part hereof. (damage to left air cleaner included at 100% of cost and not at 28% as set forth in damage assessment)

15. As a result of the negligence and carelessness of the Defendant, William E. Broll, Jr., as above described, the Plaintiff also suffered the following damages:

- a. seven (7) days of downtime at \$300.00 per day- \$2,100.00
- b. damage to right tool box in trailer- \$750.00

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff, Jason T. Bertothy, demands judgment against the Defendant, William E. Broll, Jr. in the amount of Fifteen Thousand Four Hundred Thirty-nine and 97/100 Dollars (\$15,439.97) plus costs.

COUNT II

JASON T. BERTOTHY vs. WALLACE TRANSPORTATION, INC.

16. The averments of Paragraphs 1 through 13 of this Complaint are incorporated herein by reference thereto as fully as the same are set forth above.

17. The negligence of the Defendant, William E. Broll, Jr., is imputed to the Defendant, Wallace Transportation, Inc., under the theory of respondent superior.

18. In addition, the negligence and carelessness of Wallace Transportation, Inc., Defendant, in its own right, consisted of the following:

- a. It failed to make certain that all parts of the crushed automobiles were properly secured prior to the aforesaid tractor-trailer rig being driven onto Interstate 80;

- b. It permitted loose objects to be located on the aforesaid trailer which were then scattered onto the traveled portion of Interstate 80;
- c. It failed to properly inspect the aforesaid trailer for loose objects;
- d. It permitted its agent, workman, and employee, William E. Broll, Jr., Defendant, to operate the aforesaid tractor-trailer when it knew or should have known that loose objects would be scattered onto Interstate 80;
- e. It permitted its agent, workman, and employee, William E. Broll, Jr., Defendant, to operate the aforesaid tractor-trailer when it knew or should have known that objects would be dislodged from the crushed automobiles during the operation of the aforesaid tractor-trailer which would then be scattered on Interstate 80.

19. As a result of the negligence and carelessness of the Defendant, Wallace Transportation, Inc., as above described, the Plaintiff's Peterbilt tractor suffered damages, and the cost to repair these damages was Twelve Thousand Five Hundred Eighty-nine and 97/100 Dollars (\$12,589.97) as set forth on an damage assessment which is attached hereto and is made part hereof. (damage to left air cleaner included at 100% of cost and not at 28% as set forth in damage assessment)

20. As a result of the negligence and carelessness of the Defendant, Wallace Transportation, Inc., as above described, the Plaintiff also suffered the following damages:

- a. seven (7) days of downtime at \$300.00 per day- \$2,100.00
- b. damage to right tool box in trailer- \$750.00

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff, Jason T. Bertothy, demands judgment against the Defendant,
William E. Broll, Jr. in the amount of Fifteen Thousand Four Hundred Thirty-nine and 97/100
Dollars (\$15,439.97) plus costs.







AND NOW, comes the Defendant WILLIAM E. DROLL, JR., by and through his attorney, DAVID C. MASON, ESQUIRE, and files the following Answer to Plaintiff's Complaint:

1. ADMITTED.

2. ADMITTED IN PART DENIED IN PART. Defendant's correct name is William E. Droll, Jr., as opposed to William E. Broll, Jr., as contained in Plaintiff's Complaint.

3. ADMITTED.

4. ADMITTED.

5. DENIED. After reasonable investigation Answering Defendant is without knowledge or information sufficient to form a belief as to the truth of this averment. Therefore, the same is denied and strict proof thereof is demanded at the time of trial.

6. ADMITTED.

7. DENIED. Paragraph 7 of Plaintiff's Complaint contains a statement which is a conclusion of law not an averment of fact and therefore no response is necessary or required. To the extent a response is deemed necessary, the averment contained in Paragraph 7 is denied and strict proof thereof, to the extent deemed relevant, is demanded at the time of trial.

8. ADMITTED.

9. DENIED. The averment contained in paragraph 9 of Plaintiff's Complaint is denied and after reasonable investigation Answering Defendant is without knowledge or information sufficient to form a belief as to the truth of said averment and strict proof thereof is demanded at the time of trial.

I did not have that information, so that needs to be taken off of this estimate as well. Also, attached you will find a set of photographs that the owner provided to me showing the vehicle that was in front of him and the load that was falling off of it. Also, attached you will find photographs showing the damages to this vehicle along with explanations of those photographs. You will also find attached copies of slips from L.A. Truck Repair for the temporary repairs and a copy from Cleveland Brothers for the oil pan replacement that has not been done yet. I have discussed this truck with Jim Galbreath and, as per our phone conversations, I have talked with two (2) shops in this general area about the fender and grill. I have decided to go ahead and replace them, because it would not be 100% certain that they could be repaired. Also, we have discussed the possibility of holding back funds until all of these items would be replaced, especially the higher priced items, such as the fuel tank, the right front fender, the grill and, possibly, the air cleaner case or canister. I will let that up to you whether you want to hold back funds until the owner would have them replaced. If you do so, we could pick up the salvage items at that time and sell them to a salvage buyer. Otherwise, this estimate and information should be self-explanatory.

PRETRIAL MEMORANDUM

I- FACTS

On April 1, 2002, and all times material to this Complaint, the Plaintiff was operating his 1997 Peterbilt, Model 379, tractor which was towing a trailer on Interstate 80 in the eastern part of Pennsylvania. At the same time and place, William E. Droll, Jr., an employee and agent of Wallace Transportation, Inc. was operating a tractor-trailer, on behalf Wallace Transportation, Inc., at a point in front of the Plaintiffs' tractor-trailer.

The tractor-trailer which was being operated by the Defendant, William E. Droll, Jr., was hauling crushed automobiles. Suddenly and without warning, debris fell from his tractor-trailer unit onto the traveled portion of Interstate 80 and struck the tractor-trailer owned by the Plaintiff, Jason T. Bertothy, which caused damages to them.

The Plaintiff has filed the within lawsuit against the Defendants on account of their negligence in not properly securing the material which was being hauled.

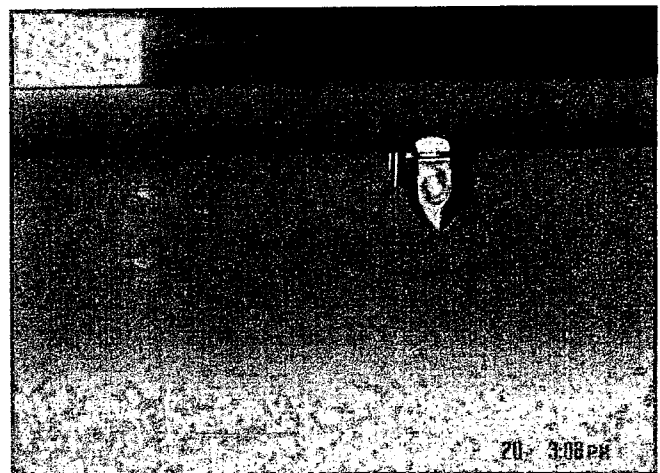

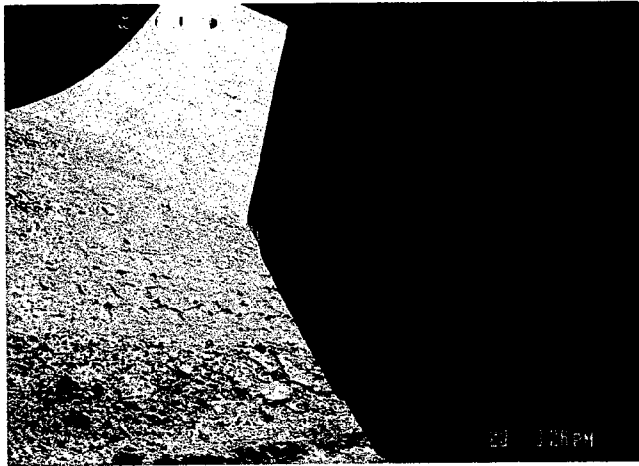

These would be the 2 patch plugs and labor for the tire as the appraisal calls for replacement of the tire and the oil pan patch and 10 gal of oil and also the drain and repair of the fuel tank.


