For Value Received, the undersigned jointly and severally promise to pay to said Lender, at its said office, the actual amount of this loan as shown above, together with interest at the rate of 3% per month on that part of the unpaid principal balance not in excess of \$150.00 and 2% per month on that part of the unpaid principal balance in excess of \$150 but not in excess of \$300 and 1% per month on any remainder of the unpaid principal balance in 24 successive monthly instalments the first of said installments to be due on Sept. 7, 1959, 19_____, and each subsequent instalment to be due respectively on the same day of each succeeding month thereafter; the final instalment being due and owing on the due date of final instalment shown above. Each instalment shall be \$28.00, except that the final instalment shall be equal to the unpaid principal plus interest accrued and unpaid at the time said final instalment is paid. 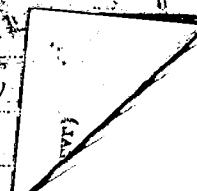

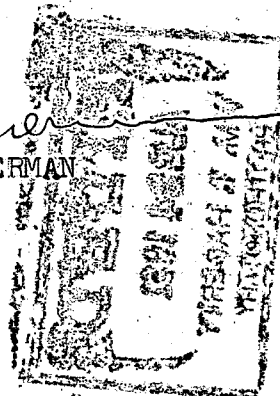
