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

AND NOW, the Plaintiff, by and through her Attorney, David C. Mason, files this Complaint against the Defendant of which the following are averments of fact:


1. Plaintiff is an individual, with an office and place of business at 740 Laurel Run Road, West Decatur, Pennsylvania, 16878.
2. Defendant is G&R Excavating & Demolition, Inc., which, upon information and belief is a Pennsylvania Business Corporation, with an office and place of business at 5 Gardner Road, Tyrone, Pennsylvania, 16686.
3. Defendant purchased construction materials from the said Dixon Contracting & Supply, and charged said purchases to an open account.
4. Defendant has failed and refused and continues to fail and refuse to pay the balance of the account due despite Plaintiff's repeated requests to do so.
5. The outstanding balance of the account as of April 30, 2003, is \$14,610.97.
6. The interest on this account will continue to be added to the principal in the

amount of 1.5% per month.

7. There are no set offs or claims against this debt.



ANSWER TO COMPLAINT

NOW comes the Defendant, G&R Excavating & Demolition, Inc., by and through its attorneys, the Law Offices of Gieg, Gieg, Montgomery & Zang, and files the following Answer to Complaint:

1. Admitted.
2. Admitted.
3. Defendant is without specific information as to the truth of the averment in paragraph 3 and strict proof is demanded at time of trial.
4. It is specifically denied that the Defendant has failed and/or refused to make any payments on said account and strict proof of the same is demanded at time of trial.
5. It is specifically denied that Plaintiff is owed any monies and strict proof of the same is demanded at time of trial.
6. It is specifically denied that Plaintiff is entitled to any interest on said balance as it is denied that Plaintiff is entitled to any monies.
7. It is specifically denied that there exists no set-offs or claims against the Plaintiff which are owed to Defendant.

WHEREFORE, Defendant requests Plaintiff's Complaint be denied and dismissed.

COUNTER-CLAIM

1. The Counterplaintiff is G&R Excavating and Demolition, Inc., a Pennsylvania corporation with an address of 5 Gardner Road, Tyrone, Blair County, Pennsylvania, 16686.

2. The Counterdefendants are Thomas Dixon and Brenda L. Dixon, i/t/d/b/a Dixon Contracting & Supply with an office and place of business at 740 Laurel Run Road, West Decatur, Pennsylvania, 16878.

3. On or about March 1, 2003, the Counterdefendants were in possession of a D755 Komatsu Crawler Frontend Loader that was the property of the Counterplaintiff.

4. For a period of approximately fourteen (14) days the Counterdefendants refused to return said property and unlawfully coveted said property.

5. Said piece of equipment was used regularly in the regular course of business.

6. By the unlawful detaining of said equipment by Counterdefendants, Counterplaintiff lost the ability to use said equipment that is billed out at \$125.00 per hour.


15. For a period of fourteen (14) days at eight (8) hours per day, Counterplaintiff lost the income from said equipment, for a total of \$14,000.00.

16. As a result of the unlawful detention of said equipment without any judgment or valid legal reason for the detention of said property, the Counterplaintiff is entitled to punitive damages not to exceed \$20,000.00.

WHEREFORE, the Counterplaintiff, G&R Excavating and Demolition, Inc., requests this Honorable Court to enter a Judgment against the Counterdefendant in the amount of \$14,000.00, plus punitive damages not to exceed \$20,000.00, plus reasonable interest and costs of suit.





AND NOW, comes the Plaintiff, BRENDA L. DIXON, by and through her attorney, DAVID C. MASON, ESQUIRE, and files the following Reply to Defendant's Counter-Claim:

1. ADMITTED.

2. DENIED. The averment contained in paragraph 2 of the Counter-Claim is strictly denied, and it is averred that Brenda L. Dixon is the owner of Dixon Contracting & Supply, which averment is admitted by the Defendant in paragraph 1 of its Answer. Thomas Dixon is not a party to this litigation and is not *sui juris*.

3. ADMITTED.

4. DENIED. The averment contained in paragraph 4 of Defendant's Counter-Claim is strictly denied as Plaintiff did not refuse to return said property and did not

covet [sic] said property. Strict proof thereof, to the extent deemed relevant, is demanded at the time of trial. By way of further Answer, please see New Matter.

5. DENIED. After reasonable investigation the averment contained in paragraph 5 is denied as the Plaintiff is without knowledge or information sufficient to form a belief as to the truth of the same. Strict proof thereof, to the extent deemed relevant, is demanded at the time of trial. By way of further answer, please see New Matter.

6. DENIED. After reasonable investigation the averment contained in paragraph 6 is denied as the Plaintiff is without knowledge or information sufficient to form a belief as to the truth of the same. Strict proof thereof, to the extent deemed relevant, is demanded at the time of trial. By way of further answer, please see New Matter.

15. [sic] DENIED. After reasonable investigation the averment contained in paragraph 15 is denied as the Plaintiff is without knowledge or information sufficient to form a belief as to the truth of the same. Strict proof thereof, to the extent deemed relevant, is demanded at the time of trial. By way of further answer, please see New Matter.

16. DENIED. Paragraph 16 contains a conclusion of law not an averment of fact and therefore no response is necessary or required. However, to the extent an Answer is deemed necessary, the averment that Defendant is entitled to punitive damages is denied.

NEW MATTER

17. The equipment identified in paragraph 3 of Defendant's Counter-Claim wintered with the Plaintiff.

18. When the said loader became inoperable in November of 2002, Defendant vacated the lands of Plaintiff, Defendant laid off his employees and abandoned the loader until spring.

19. In March, Defendant returned to Plaintiff's place of business and began to attempt the repairs necessary to regain the possession and use of the loader.


20. Plaintiff assisted the Defendant in its attempts to render the loader operable, and offered to assist with the use of a bulldozer the loading of the equipment on a trailer for removal and relocating.






