
Dear Merrill Jones:

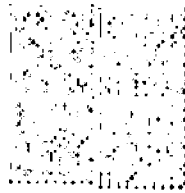


