ROAD VIEWER'S REPORT.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 8 day of November, A. D., 1869, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Brady, in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience ~~for the want of a road or highway, leading from~~

*The Farm of Christian
Walker at Jefferson County Line to at or near
John Kuntz in Brady Township*

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Geo. C. Kirk, Ellis Smith and J. R. Rishel Jr. & Eli Harmon
who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect to the best ground for a road, and the

shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

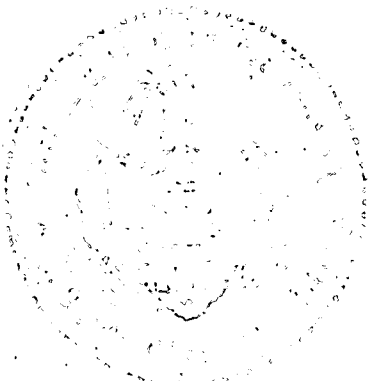

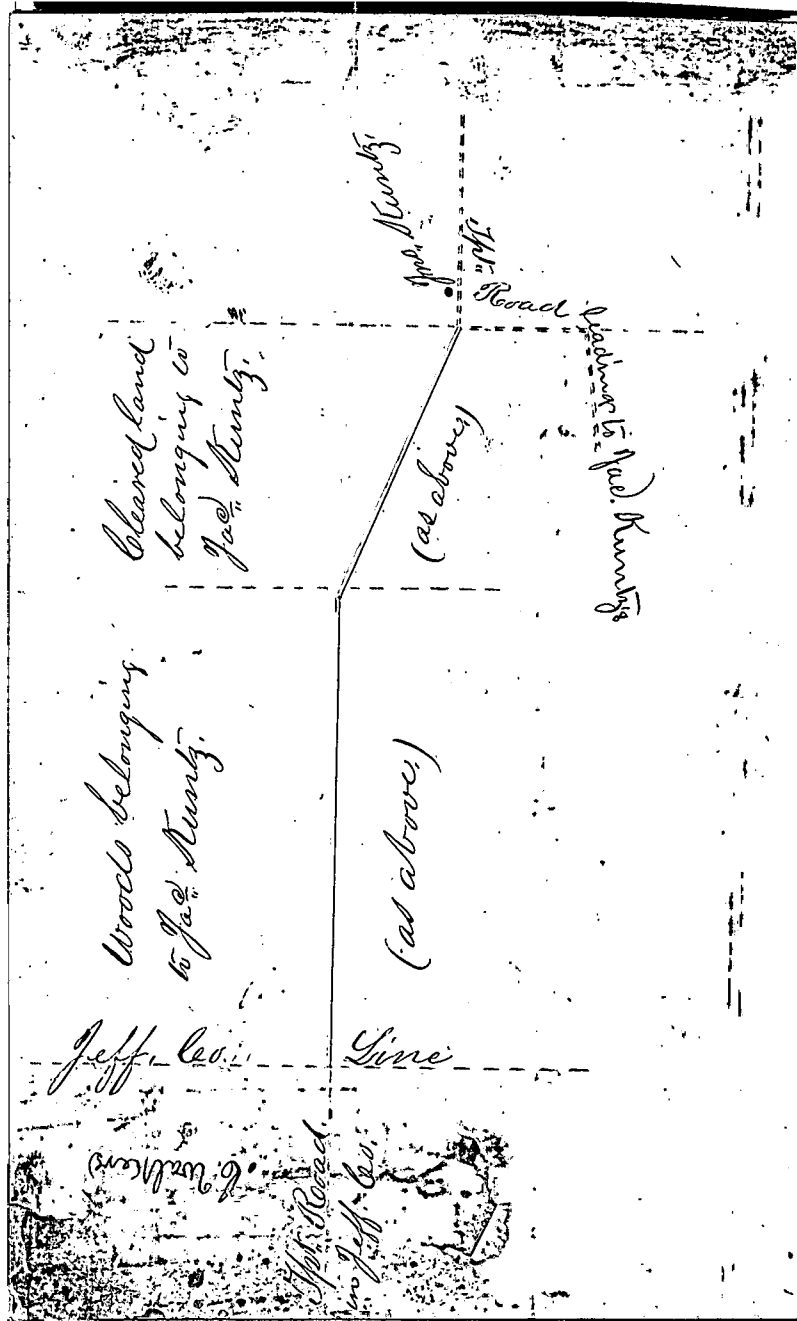

BOARD OF ALTERNATES

ALTERNATES

At a Board of Alternates of the County of Jefferson, held at the Court House, on the 28th day of March, 1870, the following was adopted:



To the Honourable Judges within named,
We the viewers appointed by the foregoing
order of court, Do report that in pursu-
ance of said appointment, we all met and
after having been severally sworn accord-
ing to Law, and also having given due no-
tice according to law of the time and place
of said view, and we having enquired of
damages resulting to any one by reason
of the passing of said road, have ascertain-
ed that damages are claimed by Jas. Kuntz,
through whose land said road passes, and
we having taken into Consideration the adv-
antages to be derived to the said Jas. Kuntz,
from the road passing through his land we
have assessed the damages sustained by
the said Jas. Kuntz, at thirty-three dollars.
And we further report that we have vie-
wed laid out and do return for public
use the following road, Beginning at the
farm of Christian Walker, at Jefferson County
line thence S. 89° E. through lands of Jas.
Kuntz, ninety-six perches to a Beech
thence S. 65° E. through lands of said Kuntz,
sixty perches, to a post in Ept. road near
Jas. Kuntz, a plot or draft of which we here-
unto annex, In testimony whereof we have here-
unto set our hands and seals this thirty-first day
of December A. D. 1869

that the Labour under great inconvenience
for want of a review of a part of the
publick Road leading from Madera to
Smiths Mills & known as the Wheat Land road
a part of said road being in the village of
Madera and by the Laying out of the said
village the afore said road runs diagonally
through lots to the great Damage of the Lot
owners.

Your Petitioners therefore Pray your
Honours that you will appoint proper persons
to review and locate the said road from where
it diverges from the Clefield road in the
village of Madera to a point on the said
Wheat Land road at or near what is known
as the Killenstine Shantys and report thereon
according to Law.
