ORDINANCE NO. 2003-13

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF HIGH STREET AND AN UNNAMED, LAWRENCE TOWNSHIP, CLEARFIELD COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

WHEREAS, Martin J. Moore has petitioned the Lawrence Township Supervisors to vacate a portion of High Street and an unnamed alley; and

WHEREAS, the Lawrence Township Supervisors have given public notice and notice to the owners adjacent to the unknown alley ten (10) days in advance of the hearing that was held on October 7, 2003 at 2:15 p.m. to inquire into the merits of vacating the unknown alley;

AND WHEREAS, the hearing was held and no one appeared to object to said action.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED:

1. That a portion of High Street and an unnamed alley is hereby vacated and closed and removed from the Township road system. The road vacated extends South to Moore corner pin (460'), also East 206' to corner pin and also unnamed alley between Lot 1, 2, and 3 (206.6') East and 16' East to West.

2. The Lawrence Township Secretary is directed to record this Ordinance together with the attached draft of the alley being vacated in the Prothonotary's Office of the Court of Common Pleas, of Clearfield County.

Enacted and Ordained this 21st day of October, 2003 by the Board of Township Supervisors.
