

TO THE HONORABLE JOHN J. PENTZ, PRESIDENT JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

The joint petition of Donna J. Dickson, a minor, by Elva Thompson, her mother and natural guardian, and Elva Thompson, in her own right, by their attorney, Richard M. Sharp, Esquire, and Nationwide Mutual Insurance Company, insurance carrier for both of the defendants above named, by Dan P. Arnold, Esquire, their attorney, respectfully represents:

1. That Donna J. Dickson is a minor of the age of 16 years and resides with her mother, Elva Thompson, in Osceola Mills, Pennsylvania.

2. That Donna J. Dickson, the above named minor, was, on June 17, 1960 at about 7:55 P. M. standard time, a passenger in a motor vehicle being operated by the defendant, Mac Dickson.

3. That on the date and at the time aforesaid, the motor vehicle being operated by the defendant, Mac Dickson, was struck headon by the motor vehicle being operated by Richard F. Dotts, who was approaching in the opposite direction, said collision occurring about four miles west of Irvona, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania on Legislative Route 17022.

4. That as a result of the aforesaid collision, Donna J. Dickson suffered lacerations of the face, multiple contusions of the face and chest, a fracture of the alveolar process of the

superior maxilla and loss of two incisor teeth.

5. That as a result of the aforesaid accident and the injuries received by Donna J. ~~MDickson~~, Elva Thompson incurred the following expenses for the treatment of her minor daughter:

6. That both of the defendants above named are insured by Nationwide Mutual Insurance Company which company has negotiated a settlement with Richard M. Sharp, attorney for the minor plaintiff and her mother, for the injuries received by Donna J. ~~MDickson~~ for the gross amount of Seven hundred fifty (\$750.00) Dollars.

7. That your petitioner, Dan P. Arnold, Esquire, represents Nationwide Mutual Insurance Company for the purpose of preparing the necessary papers to present your Honorable Court for approval of the settlement and has performed no services for the plaintiffs herein who have been represented at all times by your other petitioner, Richard M. Sharp.







Dear Mr. Arnold:

As per your request we are sending the following information on Richard and Donna Thompson.

Richard Thompson was admitted to the Philipsburg Hospital at 10:03 P.M. on 6-17-60. At the time of admission he had a laceration of the scalp and evidence of a head injury. The scalp was sutured, and a few hours following admission he developed a motor aphasia with paralysis of the right side of the body. Because of the severity of the head injury, he was immediately transferred to the Mercy Hospital in Pittsburgh. We have not seen Mr. Thompson since his transferral to Pittsburgh. We have a report from Dr. Richard Hershey, neurosurgeon at the Mercy Hospital, stating that Mr. Thompson was admitted there on 6-18-60 and discharged on 8-6-60. At the time of discharge he had a complete motor aphasia with a minimal residual left hemiparesis. Prognosis for complete recovery of function was guarded. Since we have not seen Mr. Thompson since his discharge from the Philipsburg Hospital on 6-18-60, we can give no further report as to his condition.

Donna Thompson was admitted to the Philipsburg Hospital 6-17-60. She had lacerations of the face, multiple contusions of the face and chest, a fracture of the alveolar process of the superior maxilla, and loss of two incisor teeth. The lacerations were sutured. Sutures were removed on 6-22-60, and Miss Thompson was discharged the same day. We have not seen her since that time and can render no further report as to her condition.


