

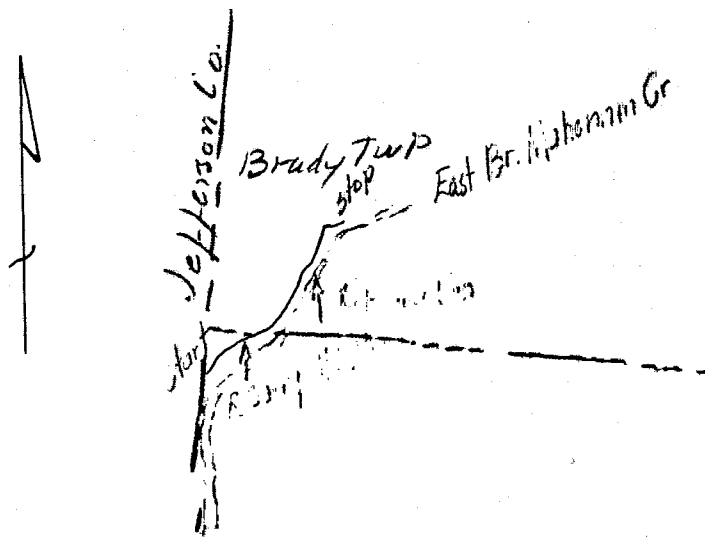

ROAD VIEWERS.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield' in and for said county, on the 29th day of June, A. D. 1869, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Brady, in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from

W. L. Hebers,

(on public Road) to intersect a
public Road at Jefferson County
line near residence of H. Anthony

Report as to damages &c.

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Roswell Luther, dean, Richel and C. Hock
who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the

shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

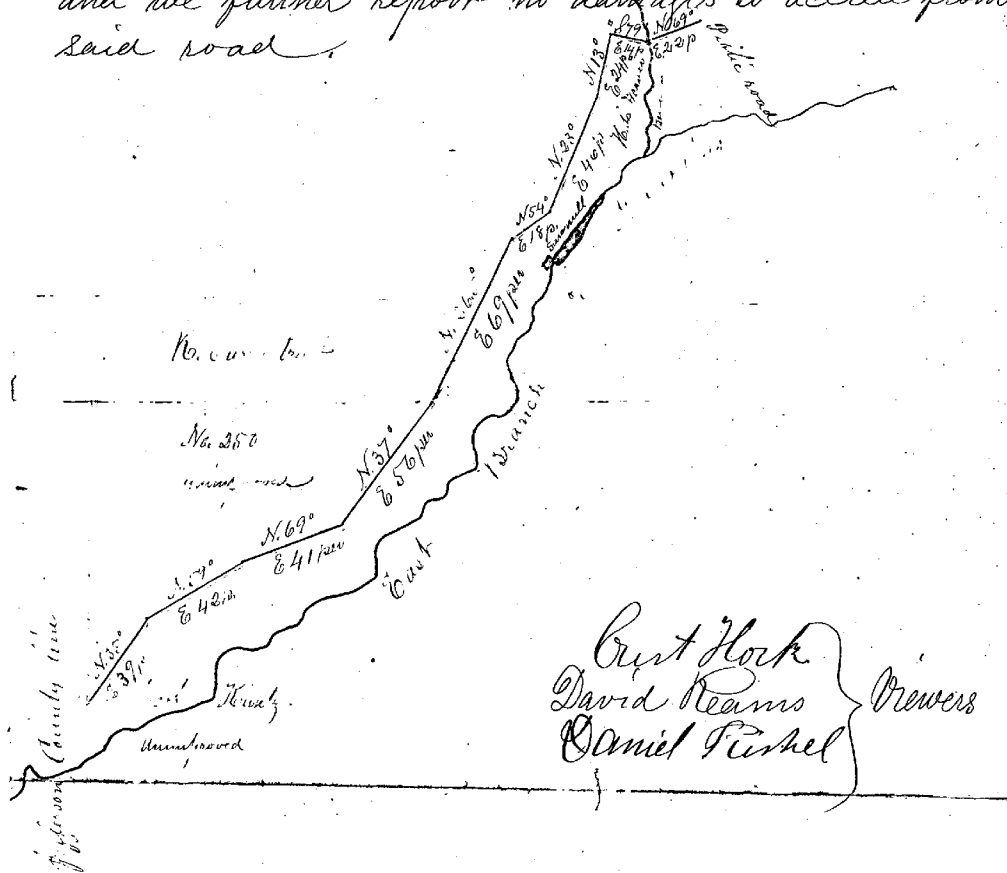

We the undersigned viewers appointed by
the above order of Court to view and lay
out the road therein mentioned respectfully report

That having given due and public
notice of the time and place of said view
by printed handbills as required by the act
of Assembly, we met at the time and place
appointed and after being duly sworn or affirmed
according to law, and all the viewers being
present we met upon the ground proposed for
said view, and having viewed the same we
report for public use the following road to wit

Beginning on the Jefferson County line thence through
wood land of Jacob County North 35° E. 39 perches, thence
N. 59° E. 42 per. thence through Robert Curry tract N. 25°
N. 69° E. 41 per. thence N. 37° E. 56 per. thence N. 26.5° E. 69 per
thence through land of W. L. Weaver and opposite the Saw-
mill N. 54° E. 18 per. thence N. 23° E. 46 per. thence N. 13°
E. 24 per. thence S. 79° E. 14 per thence N. 69° E. 22 per. to the
public road a plot or draft whereof is herewith
annexed which said road we report as necessary
and we further report no damages to accrue from
said road.
