**PETITION FOR REVIEW OF ORDER OF**  
**DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION**  
**SUSPENDING OPERATING PRIVILEGE**

1. That Petitioner is Cory Edward Rowles, an adult individual, who resides at 1315 Turnpike Avenue, Clearfield, Pennsylvania 16830.

2. That your Petitioner was arrested for driving under the influence of alcohol in the State of Ohio on or about May 14, 2003.

3. That your Petitioner pled guilty to driving while under the influence in the State of Ohio on or about May 14, 2003.

4. That on or about May 14, 2003, the State of Ohio suspended Petitioner's license for a period of six (6) months at which time Petitioner's driver's license was forwarded to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.

5. That Petitioner's operating privilege in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has been suspended since on or about May 14, 2003.

6. That Petitioner's operating privilege in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania remains suspended and in the possession of the Department of Transportation as of the date of this Petition.

7. That by letter dated December 10, 2003, Petitioner was notified in writing by the Department of Transportation that his driving privilege is suspended for a period of one (1) year effective January 14, 2004, at 12:01 a.m. A copy of said notice is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

8. That the notice attached hereto as Exhibit "A" provides that Petitioner's operating privilege is to be suspended as a result of the violation of May 14, 2003, as authorized by §1532(b) of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code.

9. That Petitioner's operating privilege has already been suspended by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Transportation since on or about May 14, 2003, a period in excess of seven (7) months.


10. That the suspension of Petitioner's operating privilege to be effective January 14, 2004, is improper and unlawful for the following reasons:

A. Petitioner is currently serving a suspension of his operating privilege as a result of an arrest and conviction in the State of Ohio on May 14, 2003, which suspension was imposed by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.

B. 75 Pa.C.S.A. §1581 of the Vehicle Code does not authorize the Department of Transportation to suspend a licensee's operating privilege twice for the same offense.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests that the Court set this matter for de novo hearing pursuant to 75 Pa.C.S.A. §1550 and that the suspension order of the Department of Transportation be set aside.
