



has already purchased a house. These findings, along with other factors, weigh on the determination of the Court in the distribution scheme adopted in this Order.

1. During the marriage of twenty-seven years, Wife contributed to the acquisition of assets through her efforts, including her activities in managing the rental properties and her contribution as a homemaker and caregiver to the children of the parties. Both parties confirmed they had a comfortable lifestyle which included frequent vacations, as well as living in an upscale home. With limited education, the parties accumulated a noteworthy marital estate. Because of her lower income, Wife testified that she was forced to use the marital assets in her possession to offset her living expenses and that she would have to use marital assets to purchase a new car. On the other hand, Husband has purchased a home for himself subsequent to the separation. Unlike Husband, Wife does not have adequate income to support a lifestyle similar to that she experienced in her marriage. Furthermore, upon entry of the divorce, Wife will have to secure and pay for private health insurance which is estimated to cost a minimum of \$215.21 per month. These findings, along with other factors, weigh on the determination of the Court in the distribution scheme adopted in this Order.

15. The parties have incurred various expenses in connection with maintaining joint assets pending the divorce, which expenses have been styled as "marital liabilities" for purposes of accounting for them. Although Husband claimed the payment of a number of expenses which totaled \$22,488.70, he failed to identify or itemize with particularity the expenses involved. Wife's listing of \$10,926.46 clearly identifies the creditors and amounts that Husband paid during the last year the parties occupied the marital home, yet were separated. Wife's listing is more reliable. Wife further made claim for similarly
