**COMPLAINT**

AND NOW, comes Plaintiff, Janet Satterlee, by and through her attorneys, Hopkins Heltzel LLP, and states as follows:

1. Plaintiff, Janet Satterlee, is an adult individual maintaining a principal residence at R.D. #1, Box 234B, Reynoldsville, Pennsylvania 15851, Jefferson County,
2. Defendant, Caesar Galanti, is an adult individual maintaining a principal residence in Reynoldsville, Pennsylvania.
3. On or about July 30, 2002, Plaintiff, Janet Satterlee, was driving south along Commons Drive at its intersection with First Avenue.
4. At the same time and general location, the Defendant, Caesar Galanti, was operating a motor vehicle on First Avenue when he failed to stop at the stop sign and collided with Mrs. Satterlee's motor vehicle. Mr. Galanti was traveling at a high rate of speed and the collision was violent.
5. As a result of said accident, Plaintiff suffered personal injuries.
6. The Defendant, Caesar Galanti, was operating his motor vehicle in a negligent, careless and reckless manner so as to cause his motor vehicle to collide with Mrs. Satterlee's automobile.

7. The negligence, carelessness and recklessness of Defendant consisted of the following:

- a. Operating his motor vehicle without due regard to the rights, safety and well being and position of Plaintiff under the current circumstances;
- b. Failing to maintain a safe speed;
- c. Failing to stop at a stop sign;
- d. Traveling too fast for conditions;
- e. Failing to notice the Plaintiff;
- f. Failing to take evasive action in order to avoid colliding with the Plaintiff;
- g. Failing to apply his brakes in sufficient time to avoid colliding with Plaintiff;
- h. Operating his motor vehicle in disregard of the rules of the road, and the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania;
- i. Driving his motor vehicle into the Plaintiff; and

8. As a direct, proximate, natural, foreseeable and probable consequence of Defendant's negligence, carelessness and reckless conduct, Plaintiff was placed in immediate peril and suffered severe injuries consisting of disc herniation at C-5/C-6 causing nerve root compression on her left side, a mild disc bulge at C-6/C-7 level and other injuries which may yet develop.

9. As a direct result of the Defendant's negligence, carelessness and reckless conduct, Plaintiff has suffered, and will suffer in the future, great pain agony and inconvenience.



10. As a direct and proximate result of the Defendant's negligence, carelessness and reckless conduct, Plaintiff has incurred, and will in the future incur expenses for medical treatment in an amount not yet ascertained.

11. As a direct and proximate result of Defendant's negligence, careless and reckless conduct, Plaintiff has suffered and will continue to suffer loss in the quality of her life.

12. As a direct and proximate result of Defendant's negligence, careless and reckless conduct, Plaintiff has suffered and will continue to suffer loss in the quality of her life.


13. Defendant is liable for Plaintiff's injuries described herein, inasmuch as Plaintiff's injuries are the direct, proximate, natural, foreseeable and probable consequences of Defendant's negligence, carelessness and recklessness as set forth herein.

AND NOW, comes the Defendant, *Caesar Galanti*, by and through his counsel, ROBB LEONARD MULVIHILL, DANIEL L. RIVETTI, ESQUIRE and RICHARD J. KABBERT, ESQUIRE, and files the within ANSWER AND NEW MATTER, the following of which is a statement:

1. After reasonable investigation, this Defendant is without knowledge or information sufficient to for a belief as to the truth or falsity of the averments of this Paragraph of Plaintiff's Complaint. Therefore, the same are denied and strict proof is demanded.

2. Admitted in part and denied in part. It is admitted that Defendant, Caesar Galanti, is an adult individual who formerly maintained a principal residence in Reynoldsville, Pennsylvania. Presently, Mr. Galanti resides at Christ the King Nursing Home in DuBois, Pennsylvania.

3. To the best of Defendant's knowledge, Paragraph 3 is admitted.

4. Denied as stated. To the contrary, Defendant did in fact stop at the stop sign and after cautiously looking both ways, pulled out of the intersection onto Commons Drive only to be struck by Plaintiff, who was traveling an accelerated rate of speed well beyond the legal limit.

5. After reasonable investigation, this Defendant is without knowledge or information sufficient to for a belief as to the truth or falsity of the averments of this Paragraph of Plaintiff's Complaint. Therefore, the same are denied and strict proof is demanded.

6. Paragraph 6 contains legal conclusions to which no response is required. To the extent a response is deemed necessary, denied generally pursuant to Pa. R.C.P. 1029(e).

7. Paragraph 7 contains legal conclusions to which no response is required. To the extent a response is deemed necessary, denied generally pursuant to Pa. R.C.P. 1029(e).

To the extent a response is deemed necessary, any allegations of negligence, carelessness and/or reckless are denied generally pursuant to Rule 1029(e) of the Pennsylvania Rules of Civil Procedure. As to any remaining averments, after reasonable investigation, this Defendant is without knowledge or information sufficient to form a belief as to the truth of the averments contained in this Paragraph, therefore said averments are denied and strict proof is demanded.

9. Paragraph 9 contains legal conclusions to which no response is required. To the extent a response is deemed necessary, any allegations of negligence, carelessness and/or reckless are denied generally pursuant to Rule 1029(e) of the Pennsylvania Rules of Civil Procedure. As to any remaining averments, after reasonable investigation, this Defendant is without knowledge or information sufficient to form a belief as to the truth of the averments contained in this Paragraph, therefore said averments are denied and strict proof is demanded.

10. Paragraph 10 contains legal conclusions to which no response is required. To the extent a response is deemed necessary, any allegations of negligence, carelessness and/or reckless are denied generally pursuant to Rule 1029(e) of the Pennsylvania Rules of Civil Procedure. As to any remaining averments, after reasonable investigation, this Defendant is without knowledge or information sufficient to form a belief as to the truth of the averments contained in this Paragraph, therefore said averments are denied and strict proof is demanded.

To the extent a response is deemed necessary, any allegations of negligence, carelessness and/or reckless are denied generally pursuant to Rule 1029(e) of the Pennsylvania Rules of Civil Procedure. As to any remaining averments, after reasonable investigation, this Defendant is without knowledge or information sufficient to form a belief as to the truth of the averments contained in this Paragraph, therefore said averments are denied and strict proof is demanded.

13. Paragraph 13 contains legal conclusions to which no response is required. To the extent a response is deemed necessary, any allegations of negligence, carelessness and/or reckless are denied generally pursuant to Rule 1029(e) of the Pennsylvania Rules of Civil Procedure. As to any remaining averments, after reasonable investigation, this Defendant is without knowledge or information sufficient to form a belief as to the truth of the averments contained in this Paragraph, therefore said averments are denied and strict proof is demanded.

WHEREFORE, Defendant, Caesar Galanti, demands judgment in his favor with costs of suit sustained.

**NEW MATTER**

14. Defendant hereby incorporates by reference Paragraphs 1 through 13 of this Answer as if same had been set forth herein at length.



15. As a result of the negligence forth above, all or part of Plaintiff's claims and causes of action are barred by, limited by and governed by the Pennsylvania Comparative Negligence Act, 42 Pa. C.S.A. § 7012, *et seq.*

16. Defendant pleads the defense of the assumption of the risk.

17. It is denied that Plaintiff's alleged injuries and/or damages are causally connected to the within accident.

18. It is believed and therefore averred Plaintiff's injuries and/or damages were preexisting, and as such Defendant cannot be liable for same.

19. The injuries and damages allegedly sustained by Plaintiff, if any, were the result of a superseding and/or intervening cause, and not the legal responsibility of this Defendant.

20. Defendant asserts the affirmative defenses of "last clear chance doctrine" and "sudden emergency doctrine."

21. To the extent applicable, Defendant pleads all of the defenses available under Act 57, 42 Pa. C.S. § 1702, as amended.

22. To the extent discovery reveals Plaintiff's claim are barred and/or limited by the "limited tort" option of the Motor Vehicle Code, 75 Pa. C.S. § 1705, Defendant pleads same as an affirmative defense.

23. This Defendant claims the right of setoff against any verdict or any verdict for an amount equal to any expenses for medical treatment and the like as well as Plaintiff's lost wages which may have been paid by a third party.

24. To the extent discovery reveals said accident was caused solely and/or exclusively by circumstances over which this Defendant did not have any control and/or responsibility and/or

supervening, intervening and/or independent causes over which this Defendant did not have control and/or responsibility and not in any manner whatsoever by the actions of Defendant.

25. Plaintiff has failed to state a claim upon which relief can be granted.

WHEREFORE, Defendant, Caesar Galanti, demands judgment in his favor with costs of suit sustained.

**MOTION TO STRIKE CASE FROM TRIAL LIST**

AND NOW, comes the Defendant, Caesar Galanti, by and through his counsel, ROBB LEONARD MULVIHILL, DANIEL L. RIVETTI, ESQUIRE and RICHARD J. KABBERT, ESQUIRE, and files the within Motion to Strike Case From Trial List, the following of which is a statement:

1. On Monday, March 14, 2005, the undersigned received Plaintiff's Certificate of Readiness for Trial, which was dated March 11, 2005.
2. In the Certificate of Readiness, counsel for Plaintiff certifies that discovery has been completed in this matter.
3. Defendant objects to the Certificate of Readiness because discovery has not been completed. Defendant is still awaiting all of the medical records from Plaintiff's providers and more importantly, the deposition of Plaintiff has yet to occur.
4. As such, Plaintiff's Certificate of Readiness is premature and Counsel for Plaintiff has violated L.R. 212.2(a) by certifying the matter ready for trial prior to the close of discovery.
5. Plaintiff originally commenced this action on or about February 27, 2004.
6. Defendant was subsequently served on or about April 28, 2004.
7. Counsel for Defendant served upon Counsel for Plaintiff Interrogatories and a Request for Production of Documents on August 27, 2004. (**Exhibit A**)

8. On October 14, 2004, counsel for Defendant sent correspondence to Attorney Hopkins requesting responses to the discovery requests forwarded on August 27, 2004. **(Exhibit B)**

9. On October 29, 2004, Attorney Hopkins forwarded the discovery responses and authorizations to the undersigned. **(Exhibit C)**

10. The undersigned forwarded the authorizations to the various medical providers requesting full and complete copies of the medical records of Plaintiff.

11. Counsel for Defendant received most of the medical records; however, the Dubois Medical Center, and specifically Dubois Magnetic Imaging Center, L.P., responded that Plaintiff was not in their records. **(Exhibit D)**

12. After discussions with this entity, it was revealed that Plaintiff was in fact a patient, and Dubois Magnetic Imaging has stated it would forward the records, and specifically the actual diagnostic films. To date, counsel for Defendant is presently awaiting those records.

13. The films from Dubois Magnetic Imaging are imperative in an effort to determine not only the true extent of Plaintiff's injuries, but to determine if they are related to the subject motor vehicle accident, or merely a result of an unrelated condition.

14. Upon receipt of the films, an independent medical exam and/or record review must be undertaken to fully evaluate this claim.

15. Further, on February 21, 2005, the undersigned forwarded correspondence to counsel for Plaintiff stating the undersigned would like to take the deposition of Dr. Scott Casteel. This correspondence further requested that counsel for Plaintiff advise as to whether or not he would be willing to produce Dr. Casteel or should he prefer that the undersigned subpoena

Dr. Casteel. **(Exhibit E)**

16. On March 10, 2005, Attorney Hopkins forwarded correspondence requesting that counsel for Defendant subpoena Dr. Casteel. **(Exhibit F)**

17. The very next day, Attorney Hopkins listed this case for trial.

18. The purpose of the deposition of Dr. Casteel is for discovery purposes as it is necessary to depose Dr. Casteel due to the fact that his records of Plaintiff reveal Plaintiff treated with Dr. Casteel for what looks to be low back pain in as far back as 1996, as well as neck pain and numbness in her left leg, headaches, and thoracic and shoulder pain. In addition, Plaintiff treated for back pain only six days prior to the motor vehicle accident. **(Exhibit G)**

19. A majority of Plaintiff's prior treatment dealt with parts of Plaintiff's body that she has alleged have been injured in the subject motor vehicle accident. **(Exhibit G; Exhibit H)**

20. Yet, in her Answers to Interrogatories, Plaintiff denies prior treatment to any part of her body that she alleges she injured in the motor vehicle accident. **(Exhibit H)**

21. In order to determine if Plaintiff may have sustained an aggravation to a pre-existing condition, or is treating for a new injury related to the motor vehicle accident, a new injury unrelated to the motor vehicle accident or the same conditions she previously sought treatment for, the deposition of Dr. Casteel, as well as an independent medical exam are warranted.

22. Due to the fact Defendant has not received all of the medical records of Plaintiff, a proper evaluation cannot be made until that time.

23. In addition, the deposition of Plaintiff has yet to be taken due to the incomplete medical records and her deposition cannot be taken until Defendant receives all of these records.

24. As the undersigned has yet to receive all of the medical records, or been afforded the opportunity to take the deposition of Plaintiff, or her medical providers, no meaningful settlement negotiations have occurred, nor can occur, until discovery has been completed.

25. This matter has not been listed for trial previously.


