DIVORCE UNDER SECTIONS 3301(C)
AND 3301(D) OF THE DIVORCE CODE

COUNT I – DIVORCE

NOW COMES, the Plaintiff, TAMMY M. COUDRIET, by and through her attorneys, Belin & Kubista, and sets forth the following Complaint in Divorce and would aver as follows:

1. That Plaintiff is Tammy M. Coudriet, an adult individual, currently residing at 623 State Street, Curwensville, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, since November 20, 2003.
2. That Defendant is John C. Coudriet, an adult individual, currently residing at R.R. #1, Box 178C, Woodland, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, since April 2001.
3. That Plaintiff and Defendant have been bona fide residents in the Commonwealth for at least six months immediately previous to the filing of this Complaint.
4. That the Plaintiff and Defendant were married on February 24, 1995 in Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.
5. That there were no previous actions in divorce filed by either party.
6. The marriage is irretrievably broken.

7. The Plaintiff has been advised that counseling is available and that Defendant may have the right to request that the Court require the parties to participate in counseling.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff requests Your Honorable Court to enter a Decree in Divorce, divorcing Plaintiff and Defendant absolutely.

COUNT II – DIVORCE UNDER 3301(D)

8. Paragraphs one through seven of this Complaint are incorporated herein by reference as though set forth in full.

9. The parties have lived separate and apart for a period in excess of two (2) years in accordance with Section 3301(d) of the Divorce Code.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff requests Your Honorable Court to enter a Decree in Divorce, divorcing Plaintiff and Defendant absolutely.

COUNT III – EQUITABLE DISTRIBUTION

10. Paragraphs one through nine of this Complaint are incorporated herein by reference and made a party hereof as though set forth in full.

11. Plaintiff and Defendant have legally and beneficially acquired property both real and personal during their marriage from February 24, 1995 until November 20, 2003.

12. Plaintiff and Defendant have been unable to agree to an equitable division of said property to the date of the filing of this Complaint.

13. That an Inventory and Appraisement of all property owned or possessed by Plaintiff will be supplied in accordance with the Divorce Code.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff requests Your Honorable Court to equitably divide all marital property.

COUNT IV – CUSTODY

14. Paragraph one through thirteen of this Complaint are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof as though set forth in full.

15. Plaintiff seeks custody of the following children:

John Charles Coudriet, II, d.o.b. 1/9/96

16. The child was born in wedlock.

17. The child is presently in the custody of Plaintiff.

18. During the past five years, the child has resided with the following:

Tammy M. Coudriet and John C. Coudriet, at Woodland, Pennsylvania from April 2001 until November 20, 2003.

Tammy M. Coudriet, at 623 State Street, Curwensville, Pennsylvania from November 20, 2003 until the present.

19. The mother of the child is Tammy M. Coudriet, who resides at 623 State Street, Curwensville, Pennsylvania.

20. She is married.

21. The father of the child is John C. Coudriet, who resides at R.R. #1, Box 178C, Woodland, Pennsylvania.

22. He is married.

23. The relationship of the Plaintiff to the child is that of parent. The Plaintiff currently resides with the parties' child.

24. The relationship of Defendant to the child is that of parent. The Defendant currently resides alone.

25. Plaintiff has not participated as a party or witness, or in any capacity, in other litigation concerning the custody of the child in this or another court.

26. Plaintiff has no information of a custody proceeding concerning the child pending in a court of this Commonwealth.

27. Plaintiff does not know of a person not a party to the proceedings who has physical custody of the child or claims to have custody or visitation rights with respect to the child.

22. The best interest and permanent welfare of the child will be served by granting the relief requested because Plaintiff has been primary caretaker of the child since his birth and can provide a more stable environment conducive to the best interest of the child.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff requests Your Honorable Court to grant physical custody of the child to Plaintiff subject to Defendant's periods of partial custody.

COUNT V – ALIMONY, ALIMONY PENDENTE LITE

23. Paragraphs one through twenty-two of this Complaint are incorporated herein by reference as though set forth in full.

24. Plaintiff lacks sufficient property to provide for her reasonable means and is unable to support herself.

25. Plaintiff requires reasonable support to adequately maintain herself in accordance with the standard of living established during the marriage.

26. Plaintiff believes and therefore avers that Defendant is employed and is capable of supporting the Plaintiff.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff requests Your Honorable Court to enter an award of reasonable alimony until final hearing and permanently thereafter.


COUNT VI - ATTORNEY'S FEES, COSTS AND EXPENSES

28. Plaintiff has employed Kimberly M. Kubista as counsel in this divorce action but is unable to pay the necessary and reasonable attorneys fees for said counsel and the expense and costs of this action.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff requests Your Honorable Court to enter an award of temporary counsel fees, costs and expenses as are deemed appropriate.

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

1. A complaint in divorce under Section 3301(c) of the Divorce Code was filed on March 19, 2004.


2. The marriage of Plaintiff and Defendant is irretrievably broken and ninety days have elapsed from the date of the filing the complaint.

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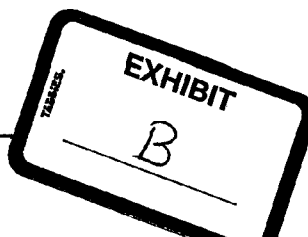
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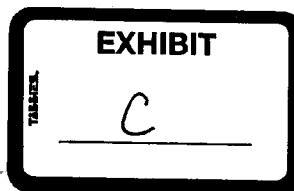

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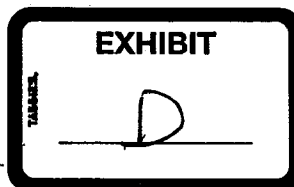
