ALL THAT CERTAIN lot or piece of ground, with the buildings and improvements thereon erected, as shown on map surveyed by Curry and Associates dated 23, 1993, SITUATE in Penn Township, Clearfield County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a 1½ inch iron pipe and stones found at the northeast corner of lands now or late of James B. Graham, said pipe being at the northwest corner of Holly D. McGee and southwest corner of Raymond G. Yose, et al, said pipe being also the southeast corner of the land herein conveyed and running; thence North 89 degrees 17 minutes 18 seconds West 540.07 feet along James B. Graham, Estate to a ¾ inch rebar set; thence North 17 degrees 51 minutes 28 seconds East for a distance of 1041.53 feet through lands of Virgie R.
