- 1-2-03 – Visited with Ryan to see how the lumber was. Ryan said the lumber was real good and when could they get more.
- 1-21-03 – Visited with Ryan he wondered about more lumber, would see that invoice is paid.
- 2-5-03 – Faxed Ryan a past due notice about the invoice.
- 3-19-03 – Visited with Ryan he said a check would be coming soon.
- 4-9-03 – Visited with Ryan, he is working on getting our payment out, money is tight.
- 5-7-03 – Visited with Ryan, he said they are working on some new credit lines and will pay soon.
- 5-21-03 – Stopped in but Ryan was away today.
- 6-9-03 - Visited with Ryan still working on the new credit lines.
- 6-13-04 – Talked to Ryan on phone, he said there should be no problem getting a check out next week.
- 7-17-03 – Stopped in Ryan was not in.
- 7-25-03 – Visited with Ryan, very close on new financing. Will pay old invoice and order more stock.
- 9-10-03 – Stopped in was told Ryan was out of town.
- 10-21-03 – Visited with Ryan working closely with new lenders to finalize a credit line.
- 11-6-03 – Visited with Ryan more of the same excuses.
- 11-16-03 - Stopped in Ryan was out. Shop was very quiet.
- 12-9-03 – Talked to Ryan, he said things are very close to being completed with the new line of credit and he would be paying us before the year is over.
- 1-16-04 – Still trying to get the credit line established, getting very close.
- 2-10-04 – Stopped in getting ready to start up again, has been shut down for awhile.
- 3-3-04 – Visited with Ryan, He said he is in desperate need of lumber, Lots of orders not getting enough lumber to get them produced.
- 3-15-04 – Talked to Ryan by phone, lots of orders but unable to get enough lumber.
- 4-6-04 – Visited with Ryan, I gave him an new updated statement showing what they owe with the interest charges. I told Ryan maybe we could work out some kind of a deal to try to get this cleaned up. Ryan said he didn't want to work out any deals, he wanted to pay us in full. I expressed to Ryan that we have reached our limit and will have to look at other ways to Collect our money. Ryan stated that he would have us half our money next week and get us The other half the following week. He said after this he would put us on a vendor guarantee List. He said he currently has two suppliers on this and it is working real well. I told him I Guess I will have to wait until next week to see what will happen.
- 4-16-04 – Called Tri-Woods left a message for Ryan to call me on the answer machine.
- 4-23-04 – Called and left a message for a return call.
- 4-29-04 – Visited with Ryan Horchen at Tri-Woods location to talk about getting our money. I explained to Ryan that we cannot wait any longer and that if we didn't have some sort of an attempt to make payment we would need to file to get it. Ryan said he would have me \$2000 by 5-5-04. I asked if I could have a check now and hold it until then. He said he would mail it.
- 5-3-04 I called and talked to Ryan to see if they have sent any payment. He said they still had not.

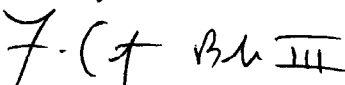

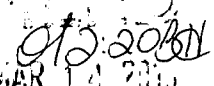
Please be advised that the Court intends to terminate the above-captioned case without notice, because the Court records show that no activity in the case for a period of at least two years.

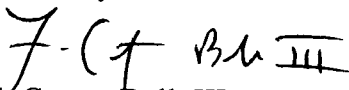

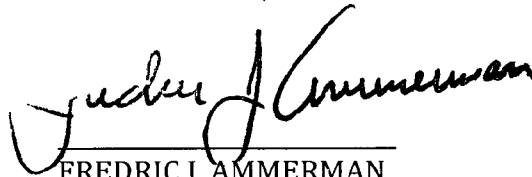
