C O M P L A I N T

The Plaintiff, H. J. Smeal, by his attorney, John B. Gates, Esq., complains of the Defendant, Charles A. Hubler, as follows:

1. The Plaintiff, H. J. Smeal, is a resident of Morrisdale, Morris Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, and operates a garage known as the H. J. Smeal garage.
2. The Defendant, Charles A. Hubler, is a resident of Morris Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.
3. On or about May 1, 1961, the Defendant orally employed the Plaintiff to repair a 1959 Chevrolet Sedan and also to install new parts.
4. The Plaintiff thereafter repaired the 1959 Chevrolet Sedan of the Defendant and completed his repairing of the same on or about May 29, 1961.
5. The necessary repairs, including parts and labor performed by the Plaintiff are itemized and attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A". The cost of repairs, labor and material being \$707.72, plus an additional \$28.31 for Pennsylvania Sales Tax.

6. That the charge for the services of the Plaintiff is reasonable and the customary charge of the Plaintiff in like cases and which amount the Defendant, Charles A. Hubler agreed to pay.

7. On or about May 29, 1961, the Defendant, Charles A. Hubler paid the Plaintiff the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars on account and agreed to pay the balance within thirty (30) days.

8. The Plaintiff has demanded of the Defendant, Charles A. Hubler, payment of the balance of the sum of \$636.03, but the Defendant has failed and refused to pay the balance or any part thereof.

WHEREFORE, the Plaintiff demands judgment against the Defendant, Charles A. Hubler for \$636.03, with interest from the 29th day of June, 1961.




