## EXHIBIT 'A'

ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate in Sandy Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northerly line of old highway Routes Nos. 119 and 322, said iron pin being at the Southwest corner of land now or formerly of Wells; thence along said highway North 82° 03' West 243 feet more or less to an iron pin at the Southeast corner of land now or formerly of Monella; thence along Monella lands North 5° 21' East 414.8 feet more or less to an iron pipe; thence along land now or formerly of McCreight South 84° 52' East 243 Feet more or less to an iron pipe at the Northwest corner of said Well's land; thence along the West line of said Well's land South 5° 21' West 406.3 feet more or less to an iron pin and place of beginning.

Said land is more accurately described in survey of Simpson and Madison, Engineers, as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron rail in the northerly line of old Route #119 leading from DuBois to West Liberty, being also the Southwest corner of land of David Wells; thence by the Northerly line of said old Route #119 North 81° 49' West 245.43 feet to an iron pipe, the Southeast corner of land of Carl Monella; thence by the Easterly line of land of Carl Monella North 5° 21' East 389.1 feet to an iron pipe in the Southerly line of land of M. I. McCreight; thence by the Southerly line of land of M. I. McCreight South 84° 54' East 245.13 feet to an iron rail, the Northwest corner of land of David Wells; thence by the Westerly line of land of David Wells South 5° 21' West 402.29 feet to an iron rail and the place of beginning.
