To the Honorable Judges of the Court of
Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County Pa.

The petition of the undersigned citizens
of Covington Township Clearfield County Pa.
respectfully represents:

That heretofore December 19th 1853 there was
confirmed absolutely by your said Court a
public Road from the Big Basin at the River
to the Turnpike road at the house of Solomon
Bander as appears by the papers on file and the
record made on Page 288 among the proceedings
of December session A. D. 1853. — That said road
was duly opened as laid out: that subsequently
at Solomons Banders and other places the said
road was changed and parts of the road as
laid out and opened were abandoned without
any ^{proper} ~~proper~~ authority as your petitioners believe;
that one of these changes is about twelve years old,
another about six, and others are more recent.

Your petitioners therefore pray the Court for
the appointment of viewers to view and report
to the Court whether changes have been thus
made, and to report whether any change should
be made in the road as originally laid out
and to accompany their report with a draft
showing ~~such changes as have been made and~~
~~also~~ such changes as said viewers may recommend
if any.

And so they pray.
