

COMPLAINT

1. The Plaintiff is the Wallaceton Boggs Municipal Authority, a municipal authority formed by Ordinance of Boggs Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania and by Wallaceton Borough, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, pursuant to the Municipalities Authorities Act of 1945, P.L. 382, as amended.
2. The Authority's address is P. O. Box 97, West Decatur, Pennsylvania 16878-0097.
3. The Defendant is Kenneth Dillon, an adult individual who Plaintiff believes resides at 198 Blue Ball Road, P. O. Box 140, West Decatur, Pennsylvania 16878-0140. The Defendant is the owner of a piece or parcel of real property with a residence thereon described in Clearfield County Deed Book 1953 at Page 363, Tax Parcel Number 105-011-580-004.
4. One of the purposes for which the Wallaceton Boggs Municipal Authority was formed was to construct and operate a sanitary sewer collection and treatment facility.
5. Boggs Township enacted an ordinance designated Boggs Township Ordinance No. 01-02.
6. Section 2.1 of said ordinance provides that the Owner of any improved property situate in the Township which is within 150 feet of a sewer line to connect to said line within 60 days

after receiving official notice to connect.

7. On August 24, 2001, the Defendant was given Notice pursuant to the aforesaid Ordinance to connect to the sanitary sewer system. The Defendant did not connect.

8. On January 2, 2002, the Defendant was notified by a Certified letter from the Authority's Solicitor that unless he connected to the system within thirty (30) days, legal action would be taken. A true and correct copy of said letter and the Return Receipt are attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibits A and B.

9. On April 23, 2002 (NT 196-02), January 31, 2003 (NT 41-03), May 27, 2003 (NT 255-03) and October 13, 2003 (NT 484-03) Private Criminal Complaints were filed with the District Justice as a result of Defendant's failure and refusal to connect to the sanitary sewer system. A true and correct example of said Complaint is attached hereto as Exhibit C.

10. In response to each Private Criminal Complaint, the Defendant entered a guilty plea at the District Justice's office.

11. The Defendant continues to refuse to connect his residence to the Wallaceton Boggs Municipal Authority sanitary sewer system.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff requests your Honorable Court issue an order directing the Defendant to connect to the sanitary sewer system of Plaintiff and to pay the tap-on and other applicable fees within a specified time period subject to being found in contempt of court for failure to comply.



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

Dear Mr. Dillon:

I am writing to you as Solicitor for the Wallaceton-Boggs Municipal Authority.

In August 2001, you were notified by the Authority that you had 90 days to comply with the Municipal Ordinance requiring you to pay a tap-on fee to the Authority of \$1,000.00, an inspection fee of \$25.00, and to connect to the sanitary sewer system constructed by the Authority. You have failed to comply with this notification.

The Authority has no choice but to commence legal proceedings to require compliance with the ordinance.

You have 30 days to comply with the statute. If you do not take the required action within this time period, legal action will be commenced before the District Justice which could result in daily fines and costs.

We urge you to give this matter your immediate attention.


Dear Mr. Shaw:
