TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:


The Petition of Tanner Joseph Peace by and through his Father, natural guardian Brian Wisor, respectfully represents:

1. The Petitioner is Brian Wisor, the father and natural guardian of Tanner Joseph Peace, d.o.b. December 06, 1995.
2. The mother of the minor child is Vickie Lynn Peace Hullihen.
3. The custody of the minor child is controlled by Order of Court dated February 11, 2003 and September 18, 2003, copies of which are attached hereto and marked Exhibits "A" and "B" respectively.
4. The minor child at present has the mother's maiden name.
5. The mother has subsequently remarried resulting in the minor child not having either his mother's or father's last name.
6. It is believed and therefore averred that it is the best interest of the child for the minor child to have his last name the same as his father's.
7. As to the minor child's middle name, Alan, is the middle name of the minor child's father.
8. It is believed that it would be in the minor child's best interest to have his father's middle name.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner requests the Court, pursuant to the Act of December 16, 1982, P.L. 1309, No. 295, § 2, 54 Pa. Cons.

ORDER

AND NOW, this 11th day of February, 2003, this being the date set for Custody Mediation, the parties being present and represented by counsel, and being unable to reach a permanent agreement regarding partial custody of the minor child, Tanner J. Peace, (dob 12-6-95), but being able to reach a temporary agreement until further hearing by the Court, it is ORDERED as follows:

1. The Plaintiff shall have periods of partial physical custody with the minor child as follows:

A. The second Saturday of every month from 9:00am until 7:30pm;

B. The third Sunday of every month from 9:00am until 7:30pm; and

C. Such other times as the parties may agree.

2. The Plaintiff shall have partial physical custody of the minor child on Saturday, February 22, 2003, from 9:00 a.m. until 7:30 p.m. and for the Easter Holiday on Saturday, April 19, 2003, from 9:00am until 7:30pm.

3. The Plaintiff shall have reasonable telephone contact with the minor child when he is in the custody of the other parties.

4. The parties will share information with the Plaintiff regarding the minor child's school and extra curricular activities with reasonable promptness.

5. This ORDER will be entered to the custody action between the Defendants at Doc. No.: 97-5-CD, with the following additions and modifications to the above matter:

A. The Defendant, Brian A. Wisor, shall have maintain primary physical custody of the minor child;

B. The Defendant, Vicki L. Hullihen, shall have periods of partial physical custody with the minor child as follows:

1) The first and third weekend of every month from Friday at 6:00pm until Sunday at 6:00pm;

2) On Tuesdays from 4:00pm until 8:00pm; and

3) At such other times as the parties may agree.

6. Parties shall refrain from making derogatory comments about any of the other parties in front of the minor child or allow third parties to make the same.


7. Parties agree that the mother's spouse, Thomas Matthew Hullihen, shall not be alone with the minor child.



NOW, this 18th day of September, 2003, following  
some argument on the Plaintiff's Petition for Contempt; both  
parties being present, being represented by counsel; it is the  
ORDER of this Court as follows:

1. The parties shall strictly comply with the  
partial custody schedule and times related thereto as set forth  
in the Court's Order of February 11, 2003.
2. The parties, being Vicki Hullihen and Mrs. Brian  
Wisor, the Juvenile's stepmother, as well as Brian Wisor (when  
he would return from the military service) shall, at all times  
discuss issues related to the partial custody schedule, any  
changes to and any issues concerning the child amongst the  
adults and shall not involve the child in the same. Under no  
circumstances will the child be used to attempt to convey  
messages between or among adults.
3. In the event that the adults involved would  
agree to deviate from the Court Ordered custody/partial custody  
schedule, their agreement shall either be in writing, signed by  
the adults, or shall be preserved through an audiotape

recording. This provision of this Order hereby authorizes any of the adults to tape-record any of their discussions, either by telephone or in person, concerning issues involving the child including, but not limited to, the child's best interests, his health, his welfare, his education and partial custody issues. The tape recording may be done through a visible or concealed tape recorder. In the event any party would come into court claiming any violation of the Court Order relative agreements made to deviate from the custody order, the Court will not consider the same without either a signed document or a tape recording of the alleged agreement.

4. Provisions 5(b)(ii) of the Court's Order of February 11, 2003, are hereby amended to provide that Vicki L. Hulihan shall have the child on Tuesdays from 4:10 p.m. until 8:10 p.m.




