


PETITION FOR REVIEW

AND NOW comes Petitioner, CHARLES WILLIAM BOCK, JR., by and through Ronald L. Collins, Esquire, who Petitions your Honorable Court as follows:

1. That Petitioner is Charles William Bock, Jr., of 1599 Shimmels Road, Morrisdale, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.
2. That Petitioner's date of birth is February 5, 1979 and Driver License No. 24931653.
3. That Respondent is the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation.
4. That by Official Notice dated July 27, 2004, Respondent notified Petitioner that his operating privileges were being suspended resulting from his conviction for failure to produce proof of financial responsibility arising out of an incident occurring on June 1, 2004. A copy of said Notice is hereinafter attached as Exhibit "A".
5. That said conviction is currently the subject of a Motion for Allowance to Withdraw Plea or To Appeal Nunc Pro Tunc.
6. That if said Motion is granted and said conviction ultimately vacated, Respondent will have no basis to suspend Petitioner's license.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests your Honorable Court to review the actions of Respondent in light of the ultimate disposition of the within referenced Motion concerning the underlying conviction.

Dear Motorist:

Your driving privilege is scheduled to be suspended on 08/31/2004, because you failed to produce proof of financial responsibility on 06/01/2004, the date of your traffic offense.

1. Your driving privilege will be suspended for three months effective 08/31/2004 at 12:01 A.M. as authorized by Section 1786(d) of the Vehicle Code.


2. You will be required to return any current driver's license or learner's permit and/or temporary drivers license (camera card) in your possession.

~~3. You will be required to provide the Department with~~
proof that all motor vehicles registered in your name are covered by a motor vehicle liability insurance policy or by a program of self-insurance approved by the Department.

You will not be permitted to operate a motor vehicle until you have been advised in writing by this Bureau that your privilege has been reinstated.

If you do not comply with this notice, this Bureau will refer this matter to the Pennsylvania State Police for prosecution under Section 1571 (A) of the Vehicle Code.

EFFECTIVE DATE OF SUSPENSION: 08/31/2004 12:01 A.M.



In order to comply with this sanction you are required to return any current driver's license, learner's permit and/or temporary driver's license (camera card) in your possession no later than the effective date listed. If you cannot comply with the requirements stated above, you are required to submit a DL16LC Form or a sworn affidavit stating that you are aware of the sanction against your driving privilege. Failure to comply with this notice shall result in this Bureau referring this matter to the Pennsylvania State Police for prosecution under SECTION 1571(a)(4) of the Vehicle Code.

Although the law mandates that your driving privilege is under suspension even if you do not surrender your license, Credit will not begin until all current driver's license product(s), the DL16LC Form, or a letter acknowledging your sanction is received in this Bureau.

WHEN THE DEPARTMENT RECEIVES YOUR LICENSE OR
ACKNOWLEDGEMENT, WE WILL SEND YOU A RECEIPT. IF YOU DO NOT
RECEIVE THIS RECEIPT WITHIN 15 DAYS CONTACT THE DEPARTMENT
IMMEDIATELY. OTHERWISE, YOU WILL NOT BE GIVEN CREDIT TOWARD
SERVING THIS SANCTION.

APPEAL

You have the right to appeal this action to the Court of Common Pleas (Civil Division) within 30 days of the mail date, JULY 27, 2004, of this letter. If you file an appeal in the County Court, the Court will give you a time-stamped certified copy of the appeal.
