WRIT OF EXECUTION

To the Sheriff of Clearfield County

To satisfy the judgment, interest, costs and attorney's commission against the Defendant above:

1. You are directed to levy upon the real estate owned by the Defendant as follows and sell his interest therein:

The property subject to this action consists of 8.31 acres more or less, known as the Morris Meadow Subdivision, Morris Township, Clearfield County and also identified by Clearfield County Tax Map No. 124-Q10-188, and more particularly described as follows:

ALL that certain tract of land situate in the Village of Morrisdale Mines, Morris Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, laying between the main line of the New York Central and Hudson River Railroad to Clearfield and the Alder Run Branch of the same railroad and bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a post on line of right-of-way of the New York Central and Hudson River Railroad the corner of Delancy H. Waring's land; thence by land of D.H. Waring North 4 degrees 40 minutes East for 886 feet to old pine stump with post driven in its roots at the South side of line; thence by said line North 90 degrees East for 110 feet to post on line of right-of-way of the Alder Run Branch of the N.Y.C. & H.R.R.; thence by line of said right-of-way on course of railroad turngust South 21 degrees 43 minutes East for 368 feet to point of curve on line of right-of-way; thence by line of said right-of-way around curve to left in a southeasterly direction for 838 feet to post and intersection of right-of-way of the Alder Run Branch of the said railroad and line of the right-of-way of the main line of said railroad leading to Clearfield; thence along line of said right-of-way around curve to right in a Westerly direction for 1012 feet to post and place of beginning. Containing Seven and Forty-Five Hundredths (7.45) acres, more or less.

ALSO BEING described, based upon a Survey prepared by Samuel B. Yost, dated December 2, 1998 as follows:

BEGINNING an a 1" iron rod set in the Southern line of Township Road T-180, St. Agnes Lane, said 1" iron rod being the northwestern corner of the land herein described; thence by the Southern line of said T-180 South 77° 01' 34" seconds East 111.23' to a 5/8" rebar set on the Southern line of T-180 and on the Western line of the Alder Branch of the New York Central Railroad, now abandoned; thence by the Western line of said Alder Branch of the New York Central Railroad the following courses and distances: South 13° 55' 13" E 365.88' to a point and by a curve to the left having a delta of 71° 29' 16", a Radius of 665.01', a Length of 829.73' and a Chord of South 51° 40' 04" East 776.61' passing through a 2" iron pipe to a 5/8" rebar set in the Western line of said Alder Branch of the New York Central Railroad and in the Northern line of the R. J. Corman Railroad; thence by the Northern Line of said R. J. Corman Railroad by a curve to the right having Delta of 30° 01' 57", a Radius of 1941.42', a Length of 1017.63' and a Chord of North 89° 25' 36" West 1006.02' to a 5/8" rebar set in the Northern line of the said R.J. Corman Railroad, thence by land of John Carl & Nancy Ann Bowman, North 13° 14' 17" East 874.95' to a 1" iron rod set in the Southern line of the aforementioned T-180 and place of beginning. Containing 8.31 acres.

ALSO granting and conveying to the Grantee, his heirs, executors and assigns any right, title and interest which Grantor may have in the rights-of-way of the New York Central Railroad which rights-of-way abound the premises herein demised to the North and to the South.
