To the Hon. the Judges of the Court of Quarter
Sessions in and for Cheshire County.

The undersigned Citizens of said County would
respectfully represent that a petition was presented to
your Hon. Court for an order to view a Road from the
Mouth of Glick Run in Goshen Township to intersect
the public Road at or near Mrs. Huttons in Gaurame
Township. Upon ^{which} a view was granted, An order was obtained
and returned the view locating a road on good and
nearly level ground.

The object of the petitioners for this road is to avoid Glick
Run hill over which by the present road it is impossible
to haul loads, and very difficult and dangerous for all
travel even when in its best condition, and always through
a great part of the winter entirely impassable by reason of
snow drifts. And this is the leading Road from all the
lower end of the County to Cheshire, the Rail Road &
the new Road will agree to one, and benefit the
public at large. No additional road taxes will be required
as it is proposed to furnish the greater part of the
expenses of making the same from other sources
than levying taxes.

We therefore pray the Court to confirm absolutely
the report of said view.
