AND NOW, comes Donald R. Reiter, who, through his attorney, Joseph Colavecchi, Esquire, files the following Petition requesting the Court to disapprove tax sale and in support thereof avers as follows:

1. The Petitioner is Donald R. Reiter an individual residing at 802 Stanley Bottom Road, P.O. Box 37, Sykesville, Pennsylvania 15865.
2. That notice has been given on October 8, 2004, and October 22, 2004, that the Clearfield County Tax Claim Bureau has given notice of a private sale of a parcel of land in Brady Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, known as Map No. 107-A5-000-006.1, et al, and described as "124 acres, minerals only," and assessed to N W Mining & Exchange Company.

3. That said sale is scheduled for December 7, 2004, at 9:00 a.m. at the Tax Claim Bureau, said sale being based on a bid of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for the parcel.

4. That Donald R. Reiter believes that the bid is inadequate and hereby submits a bid of Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) which represents twice as much as is being offered for the property.

5. That in the event the Bureau disapproves the sale, Donald R. Reiter will offer Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) and will be prepared to bid for the property in the event the Court opens the proposed sale for auction bidding.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioner prays your Honorable Court to disapprove the sale, and either accept the bid of Donald R. Reiter of Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) or open the bid on the property for auction bidding.




ORDER

AND NOW, this 23rd day of November, 2004, Petitions to For Disapproval of Private Sale having been filed by Donald R. Reiter in the above three matters, the Clearfield County Tax Claim Bureau not having filed any written response(s) and having appeared in response to the

Rule issued by this Court on October 29, 2004 and Donald R. Reiter having offered to pay an amount in excess of the original bid(s), it is hereby ORDERED and DECREED that:

1. The proposed private sale of the assessment identified by Clearfield County Tax Assessment Map Number 107-A5-000-006.1, et al. for Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars is hereby disapproved.
2. The assessments shall not be sold by the Clearfield County Tax Claim Bureau for an amount less than Four Hundred (\$400.00) Dollars.
3. The Clearfield County Tax Claim Bureau is hereby directed in accordance with 72 P.S. § 5860.613(a) to conduct an auction-style bidding of the assessments among the parties to these proceedings. The minimum bid shall be Four Hundred (\$400.00) Dollars. The bidding shall be conducted by the Clearfield County Tax Claim Bureau at its offices at 230 East Market Street, Clearfield, PA 16830 on a date selected by it, not less than thirty (30) days hereof, with at least seventy-two (72) hours advance notice to the parties. Clearfield County Tax Claim Bureau shall attempt to accommodate all of the parties to the proceeding in selecting the bidding date. Should only one party agree to pay the minimum price set by this Court, the Bureau shall sell the property to that party without the necessity of an auction.
