You have the right to appeal the Department's action to the Court of Common Pleas (Civil Division) within 30 days of the mail date (OCTOBER 20, 2004) of this notice. You must still send in your license before the effective date of cancellation unless you appear in person before a Judge and receive an order permitting you to continue to drive.
