
**PETITION FOR APPEAL FROM AN ORDER OF THE PENNSYLVANIA





MOTION TO QUASH APPEAL

AND NOW, comes the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation and requests the Court to quash the above-captioned appeal from suspension, recall, disqualification, cancellation or revocation of operating or registration privileges, averring in support the following:

1. The defendant/petitioner, Teri Sue Genco, filed a statutory appeal at the above-referenced docket number, naming the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as plaintiff/respondent.
2. The Court of Common Pleas of Clearfield County has scheduled a hearing on the appeal for September 23, 2005 at 11:30 a.m. before the Honorable John K. Reilly, Jr., Senior Judge, Specially Presiding.
3. Section 1550(a) of the Vehicle Code, 75 Pa.C.S. §1550(a), states that a copy of the petition for appeal, together with a copy of the notice of the action from which the appeal has been taken, must be served upon the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation's legal office.
4. To date, the defendant/petitioner has failed to serve a copy of her petition for appeal and a copy of the notice of the action from which the appeal has been taken on the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation's legal office.


5. The Commonwealth Court of Pennsylvania has held that an appeal, filed pursuant to Section 1550 or 1377 of the Vehicle Code, has been perfected only when notice of the appeal has been served on the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation. *Gilmore v. Commonwealth*, 590 A.2d 1369 (Pa. Cmwlth. 1991), *appeal denied*, 531 Pa. 565, 613 A.2d 561 (1992).

6. In *Gilmore*, the Commonwealth Court held that the trial court properly quashed the licensee's appeal because the licensee failed to meet his burden of proving that the notice of the appeal was served on the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.

7. In the instant case, the defendant/petitioner has failed to perfect her appeal by serving a copy of her petition for appeal on the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation's legal office. As such, the Court lacks jurisdiction to hear the instant appeal and the appeal must therefore be quashed.

WHEREFORE, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation, requests the Court to enter a rule upon the defendant/petitioner to show cause, if any, why the above-captioned statutory appeal should not be quashed because the defendant/petitioner failed to perfect the appeal by serving a copy of her

petition for appeal, together with a copy of the notice of the action from which the appeal has been taken, upon the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation's legal office.


