COMPLAINT

The Plaintiff, FISHER AUTO PARTS, by its attorneys, **KNUPP, KODAK & IMBLUM, P.C.**, brings this action of Assumpsit against the Defendant to recover the sum of TWO THOUSAND, NINE HUNDRED NINETY-FOUR DOLLARS AND FORTY CENTS (\$2,994.40), along with interest thereon at 1.5% per month from October 2, 2004, upon a cause of action of which the following is a statement:

1. The Plaintiff, FISHER AUTO PARTS, is a company organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, having its principal office and place of business at 104 West Presqueisle Street, Philipsburg, Pennsylvania 16866..

2. The Defendant, PAUL AURANDT Doing Business As AURANDT AUTO BODY, is an adult individual residing at RR 1 Box 473, Houtzdale, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania 16551.

3. Plaintiff, at the special instance and oral request of the Defendant, sold and delivered goods, wares and merchandise to the Defendant.

4. The prices charged for said goods, wares and merchandise were just and reasonable, were the legal and market prices therefor and were the prices which the Defendant orally promised and agreed to pay to Plaintiff.

5. Plaintiff's Invoices are not attached to this pleading due to the voluminous nature of same and have previously been provided to Defendant.

6. The balance due and owing by Defendant to Plaintiff is the sum of Two Thousand, Eight Hundred Seventy Dollars and Forty Cents (\$2,870.40), as appears by Plaintiff's Statement hereto attached, marked as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof.

7. Plaintiff frequently demanded payment from Defendant of said amount due and owing as aforesaid, but Defendant refused and neglected and still refuses and neglects to pay said amount of any part thereof.

8. Due to Defendant's neglect and refusal to pay the account as aforesaid, Plaintiff was forced to seek remedy in the lower Court thereby incurring costs in the amount of One Hundred Twenty-Four Dollars and Zero Cents (\$124.00), for which Defendant is further liable.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff brings this suit to recover from Defendant the sum of TWO THOUSAND, NINE HUNDRED NINETY-FOUR DOLLARS AND FORTY CENTS (\$2,994.40), along with interest thereon at 1.5% per month from October 2, 2004.


