(b) That attached hereto and made a part hereof and marked Exhibit "A" is a plot from the Clearfield County Assessment Map with the area having been vacated being marked in red.

3. That this vacation was approved following the request of Marion L. Brink, who owns the abutting property on both sides of the vacated street.





AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF
NEWBURG BOROUGH, CLEARFIELD COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, VACATING AN UNOPENED PORTION
OF BENNETT STREET IN THE BOROUGH.

The Borough Council of Newburg Borough, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania
enacts and ordains as follows:

SECTION 1.- Declaration of Purpose


Section 1.01: Whereas, the Borough Code (53 P.S. §46721) permits Borough
Council to vacate or close any street or portion thereof previously opened or laid out; and

Section 1.02: Whereas, the Borough Code (53 P.S. §46724) permits the
Borough Council to remove any streets that have been laid out, but not opened, for a period
of ten (10) years or longer from the plan of streets.

SECTION 2. -VACATION

Section 2.01: The Borough Council hereby vacates the section of Bennett
Street as follows:

That unopened portion of Bennett Street being fifty (50') feet in width and
running from Market Street in an easternly direction approximately two hundred (200') feet
to an intersection with State Route 36 as shown in red on the map attached hereto.



SECTION 3.-EFFECTIVE DATE

Section 3.01: This ordinance shall become effective forty (40) days after the date of enactment herein.






