CLEARFIELD COUNTY SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield[?] in and for said county, on the 28 day of June, A. D. 1869, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Morris, in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from

A Point on the
old Rolling Stone road near George
Hoovers and intersecting a point
on the New Rolling Stone road near
John Hoovers

Report as to damages &c

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

John B. Ryler, Amos Heubler & George Hoover
who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the

shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

To the Honorable the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace in and for the County of Clearfield We the persons appointed by the annexed order of Court to view and lay out the road there in mentioned do report, That after giving due public notice of the time and place of meeting we met agreeably thereto on the 25th day of Oct A.D. 1869 and after being duly sworn according to law we proceeded to view and lay out and do now return for Public use the following road to wit Beginning at a point on the old Rolling Stone road near George Hoovers thence through land of George Hoovers on wsec road S. 12 E. 16 1/2 Per thence S 38 1/2 E 20 Per thence S 23 1/2 E 20 Per thence S. 12 W. 40 Per thence along an old road S. 8 1/2 W 50.4 Per to line of Robert Daugherty thence on line between Robert Daugherty & George Hoovers S. 87 1/2 E 16.4 Per to corner of School House lot thence S 87 1/2 E on line between George Hoovers & School House lot 10 Per to a corner of John Hoovers thence on line between John Hoovers & School House lot S. 2 1/2 W 9.2 Per to a wsec road thence on said road through land of John Hoovers S 54 1/2 E 77 Per to a point on the new Rolling Stone road near John Hoovers ——— And We also further report that we think there will be no damage to owners of property by the making of the above described road
