The undersigned also gives to the holder hereof a lien and security interest for the amount of this note, interest thereon and the above attorney's commission, upon and in any other property, credits, securities or monies of the undersigned which may at any time be delivered to, or be in the possession of, or owed by, the holder hereof in any capacity whatsoever, including the balance of any deposit account maintained by the undersigned with the holder hereof; and authorizes holder, at its option, at any time and from time to time, to apply, at the discretion of the holder, to and on account of the payment of the indebtedness evidenced hereby or interest due thereon and the attorney's commission above provided for, any and all monies, credits, claims or deposit balances now or hereafter in the hands of the holder belonging, or owed to the undersigned, whether this obligation be then due or not. 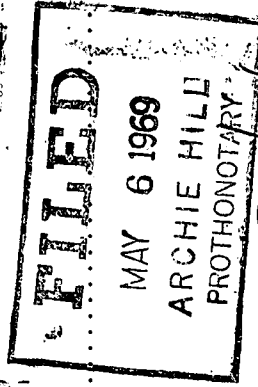
